The Auditor of the State of Hawaii, whose office is attached to the Legislature, is required by Article VII, Section 10 of the State Constitution and Section 23-4 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes to conduct post-audits of the transactions, accounts, programs, and performance of all departments, offices, and agencies of the State and its political subdivisions. Pursuant to Section 103D-304, HRS, of the Hawaii Public Procurement Code, the Auditor hereby invites certified public accounting firms to submit statements of qualifications and expressions of interest for FY 2009-10, in order to be considered for possible inclusion on a list of firms qualified to provide the services described below.

The Auditor anticipates needing the services of certified public accountants to conduct financial and compliance audits; examine related information systems and procedures of accounting, reporting and internal controls; and review for compliance with laws, regulations, and contracts of federal, state, and local government units, within the Auditor's constitutional and statutory authority.

Any contract award will be based on demonstrated competence and qualification for the type of services as described above, and at fair and reasonable prices. Award amounts are contingent upon an agency's expenditure of funds in a timely and appropriate manner. Agencies which cannot meet these conditions will have their funds reallocated to another project listed above.

Under the Recovery Act, 100% of the grant award must be expended by September 30, 2012. Any funds remaining must be returned to HUD. In order to avoid recapture, the funding awards and contracts will contain conditions to allow the City to remove funds from a nonperforming agency and transfer its funds to other funded agencies if those agencies are expending their funds in a timely manner and need additional funds to complete the project.

The Revised Final Fourteenth (14th) Year Action Plan will be submitted to HUD on June 5, 2009.
