Subject: Report on trip to Berkeley, California

Please find attached, briefings and findings of my travel to Berkeley, California, to meet with officials of California Partners for Advanced Transit Highways (PATH) on December 8, 2008.

California PATH is a collaboration between the University of California and the California Department of Transportation, along with other public and private institutions, to address safety, reliability, flexibility and productivity of California's surface transportation system.

I met with PATH's principals to investigate the capabilities of current advanced technologies to improve transportation efficiency, safety and accessibility. Their main goals are to reduce congestion while at the same time reduce travel stress, pollution, and energy consumption.

During my meeting, I previewed a rubber tire on concrete system, which will use the latest technology to navigate and automate transportation. The system is planned to be implemented in Oakland and Eugene, Oregon, and operates much like a rail system. However, the cost for the project is far less expensive than a steel on steel rail system and perfect for cities with populations of less than 2 million.
