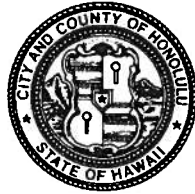

**Commission fines The Shack Waikiki, LLC for violation involving
confrontation or altercation between employee and male patron**

HONOLULU (July 6, 2009) – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 1st meeting of the fiscal year on July 2, 2009.

- The Commission denied the licensee’s motion to dismiss, and fined **The Shack Waikiki, LLC** \$1,000 for a repeat violation of Section 281-78(b)(6), HRS (failing to immediately prevent or suppress violent quarrelsome, disorderly, lewd, immoral, or unlawful conduct of any person on the premises, to wit, licensee’s employee was involved in a confrontation or altercation with another male).
- The adjudication was continued until July 9, 2009 regarding **The Shack Waikiki, LLC** for violation of Section 281-78(b)(6), HRS (failing to immediately prevent or suppress violent quarrelsome, disorderly, lewd, immoral, or unlawful conduct of any person on the premises, to wit, one of Licensee’s bouncers forcefully ejected a female patron from the premises, and/or Licensee’s other employees in the vicinity failed to subdue the bouncer’s handling of this situation, and/or Licensee’s bouncer and other employees in the vicinity failed to render assistance as patron lay prone and motionless on the ground).

During the public hearing portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Ko Olina Marina Deli LLC** for the transfer of the business and Retail General license of **Cove Entertainment, Inc. (dba Ko Olina Marina Bistro)** at 92-100 Waipahe Place, and for a change of trade name to **Ko Olina Marina Store**.
- Approved the application from **Food Pantry, Ltd. (dba Accents)** for a Retail General license at 1811 Ala Moana Boulevard (Grand Waikikian Tower, Hilton Hawaiian Village).

During the preliminary hearing, license applications and requests portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Next Door Partners LLC (dba Next Door Partners LLC)** for a Special General license on July 3, 11, and 31, 2009, at 43 North Hotel St. The Commission ordered that any noise violation will revoke the approval for the subsequent dates.

- Rescheduled to the next available date the request from **Hawaii Theatre Center** (dba **Hawaii Theatre Center**) at 1130 Bethel St. for waiver of the requirement to file annual personal history and affidavits, FBI fingerprint cards, and criminal history record clearances for all its directors except those directors serving as officers on its Executive Committee.
- Accepted the withdrawal of the request from **Doje Corporation** (dba **Sunny's Mart**) at 2215 North School St. for a waiver of Rule 3-82-31.4 to allow late submission of a tax clearance certificate to pick up its liquor license for the 2009-2010 license year.
- Denied the request from **Makaha Hotel and Resort, Inc.** (dba **Makaha Resort & Golf Club**) at 84-626 Makaha Valley Road for a waiver of Rule 3-82-31.4 to allow late submission of a tax clearance certificate to pick up its liquor license for the 2009-2010 license year.
- Approved the request from **Anekona W, LLC** (dba **The Lotus at Diamond Head**) at 2885 Kalakaua Ave. to permanently extend the licensed premises to include the entire second floor and the makai elevator servicing the lobby and the second floor.

During the other business portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Heard a report from the Administrator regarding event scheduling and work plan coordination for the upcoming 90 days.
