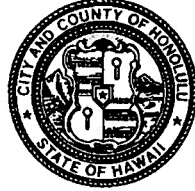

Commission terminates probation for 808, Inc. dba Club Aria

HONOLULU (July 10, 2009) – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 2nd meeting of the fiscal year on July 9, 2009.

- The adjudication was further continued until July 23, 2009 regarding **The Shack Waikiki, LLC** for violation of Section 281-78(b)(6), HRS (failing to immediately prevent or suppress violent quarrelsome, disorderly, lewd, immoral, or unlawful conduct of any person on the premises, to wit, one of Licensee’s bouncers forcefully ejected a female patron from the premises, and/or Licensee’s other employees in the vicinity failed to subdue the bouncer’s handling of this situation, and/or Licensee’s bouncer and other employees in the vicinity failed to render assistance as patron lay prone and motionless on the ground).

During the public hearing portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Jesus Santoyo (dba Just Tacos Pearl City)** for a Restaurant General license (Cat. 2 - Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 1029 Makolu St., Pearl City (Pearl City Shops).

During the license applications and requests portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Pacific International Group Limited (dba Pacific International Group Limited)** at 521 Ala Moana Blvd. for the transfer of capital stock and notification of new officer, director, and stockholder.
- Approved the request from **Uniclubs Incorporated (dba The Varsity)** at 1019 University Ave. to permanently extend the licensed premises approximately 15’ x 15’ on the kokohead side.
- Denied the request from **Lily Koi Restaurant and Lounge LLC (dba Lily Koi Restaurant and Lounge)** at 98-150 Kaonohi St., Aiea, for a waiver of Rule 3-82-31.4 to allow late submission of a tax clearance certificate to pick up its liquor license for the 2009-2010 license year.
- Approved the request from **Kyo-ya Management Company, Ltd. (dba Kyo-ya)** at 2057 Kalakaua Ave. to extend the period of safekeeping of its liquor license to June 30, 2010.

- The request from **Manhattan Boys Ventures LLC** (dba **Protea Café**) for a waiver of the requirements to submit a personal history and affidavit, fingerprint card, and criminal history record clearance for Kevin M. Showe was withdrawn.

During the other business portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Heard a status report from the enforcement section and terminated the 3-month probationary period (Apr. 2, 2009 - June 24, 2009) for **808, Inc.** (dba **Club Aria**).
- Ratified the administrative actions report for June 2009.
- Heard a report from the Administrator regarding event scheduling and work plan coordination for the upcoming 90 days.
- Met in executive session with the Administrator to discuss personnel and employment matters.
