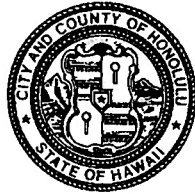

**Petitions to Impose Restrictions/Conditions on 3 Cabaret Licenses (The Shack Waikiki;
Black Diamond Nightclub; Zanzabar) Continued to Aug. 20, 2009**

HONOLULU (July 17, 2009) – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 3rd meeting of the fiscal year on July 16, 2009.

- **Zanzabar** (no contest) was fined \$1,000 for violation of HRS Sec. 281-78(b)(1)(A) (allowed consumption of intoxicating liquor by a minor on the licensed premises).

During the public hearing portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Soon Nyo LLC (dba Hill Top Grocery & Liquor)** for the transfer of the business and Retail General license at 94-307 Farrington Hwy., #A-1A, Waipahu.

During the preliminary hearing, license application and request portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Denied the request from **Lily Koi Restaurant and Lounge LLC (dba Lily Koi Restaurant and Lounge)** at 98-150 Kaonohi St., Aiea, to waive Rule 3-82-45.2(a) to permit the issuance of a cabaret license within 500' of a previously issued cabaret class, hostess category, or nudity category license. The Commission therefore took no action with respect to an application from the licensee to change its license class from Restaurant General license (Cat. 2 - Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) to Cabaret General license (Cat. 1 - Standard).
- Permitted the applicant to withdraw the Category 4 - Hostess from the application and continued until July 23, 2009, the application from **RDR, LLC (dba RDR, LLC)** at 508 Waiakamilo Rd., #508-1, for a Dispenser General license (Cat. 3 - Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing).
- Approved the request from **Legend Seafood Restaurant, Inc. (dba Legend Seafood Restaurant)** at 11 N. Beretania St. for transfer of capitol stock and notification of new officers, directors, and stockholder.
- Continued to July 23, 2009, the request from **939 Entertainment LLC (dba Club 939)** at 939 Keeaumoku St. for transfer of membership interest, notification of withdrawal of member, and admission of new member and membership holder.

- Approved the request from **Hawaii Theatre Center** (dba **Hawaii Theatre Centre**) at 1130 Bethel St. for waiver of the requirement to file annual Personal History and Affidavits, FBI fingerprint cards, and Criminal History Clearances for all directors except those serving as officers on its Executive Committee in connection with its license renewal for the July 1, 2009 - June 30, 2010 license year. The Commission also ordered the licensee to certify that all directors have not been convicted of a felony.
- Approved the requests from **Chuo Shoji Hawaii Ltd.** (dba **Ideta's**) at 620 Kohou St., **Donato's Restaurants, Inc.** (dba **Pasta & Basta**) at 500 Ala Moana Blvd., Space 4A, and **Hawaiian Steakhouse LLC** (dba **Hawaiian Steakhouse & Bar**) at 94-1211 Kunia Rd., Wahiawa, to waive Rule 3-82-31.4 to allow late filing of their liquor license renewal applications for fiscal year 2009-2010 provided the filings are made by July 30, 2009.
- Continued to July 23, 2009, the request from **ATG Enterprises Inc.** (dba **Cheers Station nka Cheers Station and Kapalama Lounge**) at 746 Kohou St. to waive Rule 3-84-72.3 regarding interior windows on interior karaoke rooms.

During the other business portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Continued to Aug. 20, 2009, the petitions to impose restrictions or conditions on **The Shack Waikiki, LLC** (dba **The Shack Waikiki, LLC**) at 2255 Kuhio Ave., Suite S-10, **Sun Ann Hong, LLC** (dba **Black Diamond Nightclub**) at 2255 Kuhio Ave., Suite M-1, and **Mystic Works, LLC** (dba **Zanzabar**) at 2255 Kuhio Ave., Suite S-8, in accordance with HRS Sections 281-61(b) and -91 and Rule 3-82-38.25.
- Reviewed liquor licenses currently held in safekeeping to determine each licensee's status in the 2009-2010 license year.
- Heard a report from the Administrator regarding event scheduling and work plan coordination for the upcoming 90 days.
- Met in executive session with Corporation Counsel and the Administrator to discuss personnel and employment matters.
