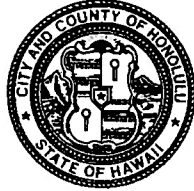

Commission Approves Tour or Cruise Vessel License for Kandoo! Oahu, Incorporated

HONOLULU (July 30, 2009) – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 5th meeting of the fiscal year on July 30, 2009.

- **Longhi's Ala Moana** (no contest) received a letter of reprimand for violation of Rule 3-84-72.1 (failure to keep premises in a clean and sanitary condition, and/or failure to comply with Dept. of Health rules, to wit, several bottles of liquor containing small dead insects).
- **Legend Seafood Restaurant, Inc.** (no contest) received a letter of reprimand for violation of HRS Sec. 281-41(j) (failure to obtain prior approval of change in ownership of 25% or more of licensee's stock).

During the public hearing portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **To Two, Inc.** (dba **One 2 Go**) at 1320 Kalani St. for the transfer of the business and a Dispenser General license (Cat. 3 & 4 - Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing & Hostess).
- Approved the application from **SSV LLC** (dba **Side Street Inn on Da Strip**) at 614 Kapahulu Ave. for a Restaurant General license (Cat. 2 - Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing).

During the preliminary hearing, license application, and request portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **TCK Corp.** for the transfer of the business and Dispenser General license (Cat. 4 - Hostess) of **OCK Corporation** (dba **Club Business**) at 1346 Kapiolani Blvd. In a related matter, the Commission also approved a Temporary Dispenser General license (Cat. 4 - Hostess)
- Approved the application from **Craft Enterprises LLC** (dba **Craft Enterprises LLC**) for a Restaurant Beer & Wine license (Cat. 2 - Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 94-673 Kupuohi St., Kunia Shopping Ctr., Waipahu.
- Approved the application from **Kandoo! Oahu, Incorporated** (dba **Kandoo! Oahu, Incorporated**) for a Tour or Cruise Vessel General license (Cat. 2 - Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 1085 Ala Moana Blvd., Kewalo Basin, Fisherman's Wharf Pier. The Commission also approved service to ticketed

passengers within the vessel before scheduled departure and after docking, and operation of karaoke machines on board the vessel.

- Approved the request from **Hilton Hawaiian Village, LLC** (dba **Hilton Hawaiian Village**) at 2005 Kalia Rd. to permanently delete from the licensed premises the commercial store space to be occupied by **Food Pantry, Ltd.** (dba **Accents**) on the second floor of the Grand Waikikian Tower.

During the other business portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Determined that the license cancellation was valid and denied a motion for reconsideration (denial of request to reinstate license) and/or request for waiver (reinstatement of license and allow late filing of application to renew license) from **VIP Restaurant, Inc.** (dba **Club Tsunami**) (former Dispenser General license No. E1267) at 655 Keeaumoku St.
- Continued to Aug. 13, 2009, the second quarterly review of its one-year probation (Feb. 12, 2009 to Jan. 14, 2010) of **Club Hilltop** nka **Club Pink Rose** at 743 K Waiakamilo Rd., to require the licensee's appearance.
- Heard a report from the Administrator regarding event scheduling and work plan coordination for the upcoming 90 days.
- Met in executive session with Corporation Counsel and the Administrator to discuss personnel and employment matters.
