**Honolulu Liquor Commission revokes license for Tondo-Tondo
and fines Cisco's Cantina for a repeat violation of selling liquor to minors**

- Harbor Court Bistro's waiver request regarding termination of its temporary liquor license denied -

HONOLULU (Oct. 10, 2008) – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 13th meeting of the fiscal year on Oct. 9, 2008.

- The adjudications against **Club Pisces** (nka **1st Time**) for two violations of Rule 3-84-78.01(b) (employee consumption of liquor while on duty), for three violations of Rule 3-84-78.042 (fondling), for two violations of Rule 3-82-38.5(a) (non-registered employee) and violation of Rule 3-82-38.4(b)(time card), were continued until Nov. 13, 2008.
- The Commission revoked the license of **Tondo-Tondo** for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(B), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor), violation of Section 281-78.5(a), HRS (licensee engaged in practices which promoted excessive consumption of liquor), violation of Rule 3-82-38.1 (licensee and their employees failed to familiarize themselves with the liquor laws and the rules of the Commission, violation of Rule 3-82-38.5(a)(non-registered employee), violation of Rule 3-82-38.4(b) (time card), violation of Rule 3-84-78.01(b) (licensee's female employee consumed liquor while on duty on the licensed premises) and for violation of Rule 3-84-78.52 (stacking). The licensee had entered a plea of no contest to the charges on Sept. 25, 2008 – the matter had been continued for penalty assessment only.
- **Cisco's Cantina** (no contest) was fined \$2,000 for a repeat violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor).
- **Zippy's** pled no contest to violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor). The Commission continued the penalty phase until the next available setting to have the licensee appear with its chief executive officer, its head personnel officer, and the individual in charge of employee training and liquor law compliance.

- **Kaneohe Market** (no contest) was fined \$500 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(2), HRS (permitting liquor to be consumed on the premises in an area not permitted by the terms of the license).

During the public hearings portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **The Shack Waikiki, LLC** for a Cabaret General license (Cat. No. 1 – Standard Bar) at 2255 Kuhio Ave., Suites S-10 & S-11 (**Waikiki Trade Center**).
- Approved the application from **LEVEL 3R and L, LLC** for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or recorded music and dancing) at 1750 Kalakaua Ave., 3rd Floor (**Century Center**).
- Approved the application from **Zenshu LLC** for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or recorded music and dancing) at 477 Kapahulu Ave.

During the request portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the request from **Kim Nguyen, LLC** (dba **Club New Saigon Nights**) for the rescission of Commission approval of Stock Transfer Application No. 17, notifying of new sole member (application approved on April 17, 2008).

During the Other Business portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Denied a request from **Robin Melchor, Esq.**, on behalf of **EHW-II, LLC** (dba **Harbor Court Bistro**) for waiver of Rule 3-82-32.1(b) (regarding termination of its temporary liquor license).
- Approved a request from **Kenneth Hoo** on behalf of **Seven-Eleven Hawaii, Inc.** (dba **7-Eleven Stores**) for a waiver of Rule 3-82-45.1 (submission of Personal History and Affidavit, Criminal History Record Clearance and Fingerprint Card for its officers and directors with license application).
