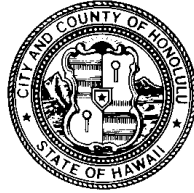

**Commission Fines Hanks Café Honolulu, Maile Deli, Waianae Store and Baci Bistro
For Selling Liquor To Minors**

HONOLULU (March 24, 2008) – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 36th meeting of the fiscal year on March 20, 2008.

- The adjudication against **Club Ariake** for violation of Section 281-41(i) (licensee transferred the licensee's business without Commission approval) was continued until March 27, 2008.
- **Hanks Café Honolulu** was fined \$2,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor). In addition, the Commission ordered the licensee to take server training classes within 90 days of receiving the order.
- **Maile Deli** was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor). In addition, the Commission ordered the licensee to take server training within 90 days of receiving the order.
- **Waianae Store** was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor).
- **Baci Bistro** (no contest) received a fine of \$1000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor). The Commission suspended \$250 of the fine provided that the licensee did not receive similar violations for a period of one year.
- The Commission accepted no contest pleas from **The O Lounge** for two violations of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor) and continued the penalty phase until April 3, 2008.

During the public hearings portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Wine by Numbers, LLC** for a Retail General license at 94-1235 Ka Uka Blvd, Unit B.
- Approved the application from **Run, Incorporated** for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 1 – Standard Bar) at 2600 South King St., Space No. KUP-107 (**King University Plaza**).

During the license portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **KG Restaurants, Inc.** for a Temporary Restaurant General (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 770 Auloa Rd., the present site of **Luana Hills Restaurant.**

During the Other Business portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Asked that the discussion regarding interpretation of HRS 281-17(a)(3) and -17.5 be placed on the agenda for the April 3, 2008 HLC hearing.
