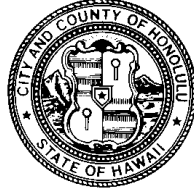

Commission grants preliminary license approval to “Side Street Inn on Da Strip”

- Also approves withdrawal of application from 7-Eleven Stores for license on Moanalua Road -

HONOLULU (June 8, 2009) – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 44th meeting of the fiscal year on June 4, 2009.

- The adjudication against **The Shack Waikiki, LLC** for violation of Section 281-78(b)(6), HRS (failing to immediately prevent or suppress violent, quarrelsome, disorderly, lewd, immoral, or unlawful conduct of any person on the premises when Licensee’s employee was involved in a confrontation or altercation with another male) was continued until July 2, 2009.
- The adjudications against **Mall Café** for two violations of Rule 3-84-72.1 (licensee failed to keep its premises in a clean and sanitary condition, to wit, bottles of liquor contained small dead insects), one violation of Rule 3-84-78.52 (stacking), one violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(B), HRS (licensee sold, served, furnished or allowed the consumption of liquor by a person who was at the time under the influence of liquor), and violation of Rule 3-82-38.4(b)(time card) were continued until June 25, 2009. The Commission also continued until June 25, 2009, the Notice of Petition and Hearing for nonrenewal of Dispenser General License No. E1407 issued to **Saiming Corporation** (dba **Mall Café**) at 80 South Pauahi St.

During the public hearing portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Momotarou Sushi, Inc.** (dba **Kaimuki Grill**) for a Restaurant Beer and Wine license (Cat. No. 1 – Standard Bar) at 1108 12th Ave., Suite C.

During the preliminary hearing, license applications and requests portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Taurian BA, LLC** (nka **Black Angus Steakhouses, LLC**) for the transfer of the Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) of **ARG Enterprises, Inc.** (dba **Cattle Company Steakhouse**) at 98-1262 Kaahumanu St. The Commission continued the applicant’s application for a Temporary Dispenser license to the public hearing date.

- Approved the application from **Pacific Spirits Inc.** for a Wholesale General license at 161 Hamakua Dr.
- Approved the application from **SSV LLC** (dba **Side Street Inn on Da Strip**) for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 614 Kapahulu Ave., Suite 100 (**Prudential Locations Building**).
- Approved the application from **Club Albatross, Inc.** (dba **Club Eagles**) for the transfer of capital stock and notification of new officer, director and stockholder at 94-867 Waipahu St.
- Continued until June 25, 2009, the request from **VIP Restaurant Inc.** (dba **Club Tsunami**) for reinstatement of Dispenser General License No. E1267, which was voluntarily cancelled on May 21, 2009.
- Approved the request from **Anekona W, LLC** (dba **The Lotus at Diamond Head**) for disclosure and approval of hotel management agreement at 2885 Kalakaua Ave.

During the other business portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the withdrawal of Application No. 1469 from **Seven-Eleven (Hawaii), Inc.** (dba **7-Eleven Stores**) for a Retail General license at 99-236 Moanalua Rd.
- Continued until June 25, 2009, a request from **Chris Kahunahana** on behalf of **Next Door Partners LLC** for a waiver of Rule 3-82-31.4 to allow late filing of license renewal application; and late submission of tax clearance certificate.
- Heard a weekly report on administrative matters from the Liquor Administrator.
- Met in Executive Session to confer with the Liquor Administrator and Corporation Counsel regarding personnel and employment matters, in accordance with HRS 92-5(a)(2).
