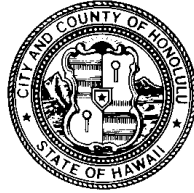

**Commission Fines Arnold's Beach Bar & Grill, Sunny's Mart  
and Shore Bird for Selling Liquor to Minors**

**HONOLULU (May 16, 2008)** – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 44<sup>th</sup> meeting of the fiscal year on May 15, 2008.

- **Bobby G's Spot** (no contest) and **Captain Zack's and the Marlin Bar** (no contest) each received letters of reprimand for violation of Rule 3-81-17.54(c) (failing to file a gross sales of liquor report within 31 days following the revocation, cancellation or expiration of the Licensee's liquor license).
- **"Los Garcias" Mexican Restaurant** (guilty) was fined \$500 for violation of Rule 3-81-17.54(d) (failing to make available for inspection and/or auditing the books and records for the last four years).
- The adjudication against **Honolulu Tavern** for violation of Rule 3-82-38.23(b) (made or permitted noise which resulted in a complaint and exceeded the maximum permissible sound levels) was continued until May 29, 2008. In a related matter during the Other Business portion of the meeting, the Commission also continued requests from **John A. Morris, Esq.** to remove the common elements from the licensed premises and to cancel the approval for installation of a karaoke system. The Commission continued the matters to allow all parties to meet with the Special Projects Coordinator, who will report back to the Commission on May 29, 2008.
- The Commission upheld the not guilty plea of **Futaba Restaurant and Catering** for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor).
- **Arnold's Beach Bar & Grill** was fined \$350 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.5(a) (non-registered employee) and fined \$2,000 for a repeat violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor). In addition, the Commission ordered all servers to complete the HLC server training class and to pass the test within 90 days. Another adjudication for violation of Rule 3-82-38.9(a) (failing to have a duly registered manager or assistant manager in active charge of the licensed premises) was withdrawn.

- **Sunny’s Mart** (no contest) was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor). In addition, the Commission suspended \$250 of the fine provided the licensee did not have a repeat violation within one year.
- **Shore Bird** (no contest) was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor).

During the preliminary hearing portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **W Steak Waikiki, LLC** (dba **Wolfgang’s Steakhouse by Wolfgang Zwiener**) for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 2301 Kalakaua Ave. (**Royal Hawaiian Shopping Center**, 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of Building C, Space No. C301).

During the license application portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Nomura Financial, Ltd.** (dba **Waikiki Gateway Hotel**) for renewal of its Temporary Hotel General license at 2070 Kalakaua Ave.

During the Other Business portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Met in executive session to discuss personnel and employment matters, in accordance with HRS 92-5(a) (2).
