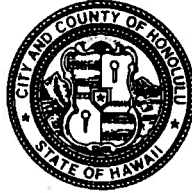

The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 25<sup>th</sup> meeting of the fiscal year on Jan. 10, 2008:

- **Arnold's Beach Bar & Grill** (no contest) was fined \$500 and ordered to produce records within 60 days for violation of Rule 3-81-17.54(d) (failing to make its books and records for the last four years available for inspection and/or auditing).
- The Commission accepted a no contest plea from **Ohana Karaoke** for violation of Rule 3-81-17.54(d) (failing to make its books and records for the last four years available for inspection and/or auditing); the penalty phase was continued to the next available setting in order to have the licensee present.
- **Club Komo Mai** (no contest) was fined \$250 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.5(a) (unregistered employee) and \$350 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.9(a) (no manager on duty).
- The adjudication against **Next Door Partners LLC** for violation of Rule 3-84-78.03(b) (entertainment causing complaints from the public) was continued to Jan. 17, 2008.
- **Porky's Sports Pub & Grill** (no contest) was fined \$1,000 each for two violations of Rule 3-84-78.042 (fondling), \$300 for a violation of Rule 3-84-78.01(b) (employee consuming liquor), and \$1,000 for a violation of Rule 3-86-101.54 (minor on nudity category premises). The violation of Rule 3-82-38.5(a) (unregistered employee) was withdrawn.
- **Compadres** (no contest), **The Greek Corner** (no contest), and **Speed Mart** (no contest) each were fined \$1,000 for a violation of HRS 281-78(b)(1)(A) (selling liquor to a minor).

During the public hearings portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Ronald U. B. Kim** for the transfer of the business and Retail General license of **Issa Hilweh** (dba **Hil-Mart**) at 159 Kaiulani Ave, #107 and for a change of trade name to **Posh Enterprise**.

- Approved the application from **The Brew Moon, Ward Centre LLC** for the transfer of the business and Brewpub license (Cat. No. 2 – Live Entertainment) of **Honolulu Brewing Company, LLC (dba Brew Moon Restaurant & Microbrewery)** at 1200 Ala Moana Blvd. and for a change of trade name to **The Brew Moon, Ward Centre LLC**.
- Approved the application from **Sung Corporation** for the transfer of the business and Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live Entertainment) of **Jeong Rok Lim (dba Dukeobi Jib Restaurant)** at 1602 Kalakaua Ave. and for a change of trade name to **Frog House Restaurant**.
- Approved the application from **Oahu Coffee and Soda Works, Inc. (dba Morning Brew)** for a Restaurant Beer & Wine license (Cat. No. 2 – Live Entertainment) at 600 Kailua Rd.

During the license applications portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Continued to Jan. 17, 2008 the application from **Red Lion University, LLC (dba Red Lion University)** for approval to cater to 2301 Kuhio Ave., proposed site of **Galaxy Steak House LLC**, from Jan. 18, 2008 to Mar. 2, 2008 (45 days).
- Approved the application from **New Bangkok, Inc. (dba New Bangkok)** for approval of the transfer of capital stock and notification of new officer, director and stockholder.

During the Other Business portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Met in executive session regarding the administrator's performance evaluation for 2007, in accordance with HRS 92-5(a)(2), and regarding personnel and employment matters, in accordance with HRS 92-5(a)(2).
