The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 26th meeting of the fiscal year on Jan. 17, 2008:

- **Next Door Partners LLC** (found guilty) was fined \$750, placed on 3-months probation, and ordered to participate in mediation and report back to the Commission in one month, for violation of Rule 3-84-78.03(b) (entertainment causing complaints from the public).
- The adjudications against **Café Che Pasta** (Rule 3-82-38.9(a) – no registered manager; HRS Sec. 281-78(b)(1)(A) – sale to minor), **Masa's Market & Drive In** (HRS Sec. 281-78(b)(1)(A) – sale to minor), **Haleiwa Chevron** (HRS Sec. 281-78(b)(1)(A) – sale to minor), and **Coyote Nights** (HRS 281-78(b)(2) – permitting consumption outside of approved premises area) were continued to the next available setting.
- **Hawaiian Waters Adventure Park** (guilty) was fined \$500 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.20(b) (open liquor after 2:00 am).
- The adjudication against **Cisco's Cantina** for violation of HRS Sec. 281-78(b)(1)(A) (sale to minor) was continued to January 24, 2008.
- **Kalapawai Café & Deli** (found guilty), **Soul De Cuba Café** (guilty), **Malama Market** (no contest) and **Tamura's Market** (no contest) each were fined \$1,000 for a violation of HRS 281-78(b)(1)(A) (selling liquor to a minor).
- The Commission accepted a no contest plea from **Fort Street Bar and Grill** for violation of HRS 281-78(b)(1)(A) (selling liquor to a minor); the penalty phase was continued to the next available setting in order to have the licensee present.

During the preliminary hearings and license applications portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **SCY Corporation** for the transfer of the business and Dispenser General license (Cat. 4 – Hostess) of **Mylynh Inc. (dba Mylynh's Sports Bar & Restaurant)** at 835 Keeaumoku St. In a related matter, the Commission approved the application from **SCY Corporation (dba SCY Corporation)** for a Temporary Dispenser General license (Cat. 4 – Hostess).

- Approved the application from **Won Suk Muico** for the transfer of the business and Retail General license of **William R. Muico** (dba **Pensacola Mart**) at 1535-C3 Pensacola St., and a change of trade name to **Pensacola Mini Mart**.
- Approved the application from **A.T. Polynesian Market, LLC** for the transfer of the business and Retail General license of **Jung Park** (dba **A.T. Polynesian**) at 87-1784 Farrington Hwy., and a change of trade name to **A.T. Polynesian Market, LLC**.
- Approved the application from **Paesano at Waimalu LLC** (dba **Paesano at Waimalu LLC**) for a Restaurant General license (Cat. 1 – Standard) at Waimalu Plaza Shopping Ctr., 98-1277 Kaahumanu St.
- Approved the application from **Gary's At Harbor Court, LLC** (dba **Gary's at Harbor Court**) for a Retail General license at Harbor Court Office Tower, 55 Merchant St.
- Approved the application from **Red Lion University, LLC** (dba **Red Lion University**) to cater to 2301 Kuhio Ave., proposed site of **Galaxy Steak House LLC**, from Jan. 18, 2008 to Mar. 2, 2008 (45 days).
- Approved the application from **Aala Produce, Inc.** (dba **Aala Ship Service**) for approval of the transfer of capital stock.

- Heard a three-month probationary status report on **J.C.C., Inc.** dba **Club Sun**; the Commission terminated the licensee's probation.
- Met in executive session regarding personnel and employment matters, in accordance with HRS 92-5(a)(2).
