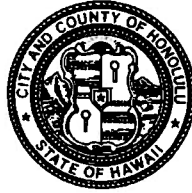

The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 33rd meeting of the fiscal year on Feb. 28, 2008:

- **Club Golden Gate** (no contest; certain charges for penalty phase only) was fined \$250 for a violation of Rule 3-82-38.5(a) (unregistered employee), \$1,000 each for three violations of Rule 3-84-78.042 (fondling), and \$250 each for two violations of Rule 3-82-38.4(b) (no time card). Charges for two violations of Rule 3-84-78.01(b) (employee drinking on duty), one violation of Rule 3-82-38.5(e) (no registration card) were withdrawn.
- **Club New D'Amour** (no contest) was fined \$1,000 each for two violations of Rule 3-84-78.042 (fondling), \$300 each for two violations of Rule 3-84-78.01(b) (employee drinking on duty), and \$350 each for two violations of Rule 3-82-38.4(b) (no time card). Charges for two violations of Rule 3-84-78.042 (fondling) and two violations of Rule 3-84-78.01(b) (employee drinking on duty) were withdrawn.
- The adjudication against **Club Ariake** for a violation of HRS 281-41(i) (unauthorized transfer) was continued to Mar. 20.
- **Verbano Italiano Ristorante** (guilty), **Hyung Je Joomooluck** (no contest), **Mai Lan Restaurant** (no contest), **77 Grill and Bar** (no contest), **Bar & Grill Lanikai** (no contest), **Mel's Market** (no contest), **Wasabi Bistro** (no contest), and **Hula's Bar & Lei Stand** (no contest) each were fined \$1,000 for a violation of HRS 281-78(b)(1)(A) (sale to minor).
- **Gyu-Kaku** (no contest), and **Yoshitsune** (no contest) each were fined \$2,000 for a repeat violation of HRS 281-78(b)(1)(A) (sale to minor).
- The Commission accepted a no contest plea from **Moose McGillycuddy's Pub & Café** and continued the penalty phase to Mar. 27.
- The Commission entered a default judgment against **Seoul Garden Yakiniku** for a violation of HRS 281-78(b)(1)(A) (sale to minor) and Rule 3-82-38.9(a) (no manager on duty) and continued the penalty phase to the next available setting to have the licensee appear.

During the public hearings portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Tenkaippin Hawaii Inc.** for the transfer of the business and Restaurant Beer & Wine license (Cat. 1 - Standard) of **Ele-Opaka Hawaii, Inc. (dba Ajitama Ramen)** at 617 Kapahulu Ave., and for a change of trade name to **Tenkaippin.**
- Approved the application from **S Plus P Corporation** for the transfer of the business and Retail General license of **S & R Pacific, Inc. (dba Hygenic Store)** at 47-528 Kamehameha Hwy., Kaneohe.
- Approved the application from **Christina Wong (dba Koha International Wine Imports)** for a Wholesale General license at 500 Alakawa St., #104.

During the license applications, preliminary hearings, temporary license applications, and stock transfer application portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Continued to Mar. 6 the application from **Sengpheth Rasmy (dba Sengpheth Rasmy)** for Special Beer & Wine license on Mar. 22 and 23, 2008 at 111 N. King St., (2nd floor of the Yee Hop Plaza, premises of Golden Palace Seafood Restaurant). The Commission directed the applicant to meet with the enforcement section and develop a security plan for the proposed event.
- Approved the application from **RMPG Industries Inc.** for the transfer of the business and Restaurant Beer & Wine license (Cat. 2 – Live Ent.) of **Ken Wilson Sports Enterprises, Inc.(dba Mama’s Island Pizza)** at 108 Hekili St., Suite 107, Kailua. In a related matter, the Commission approved the application from **RMPG Industries Inc. (dba Mama’s Island Pizza)** for a Temporary Restaurant Beer & Wine license (Cat. 2 – Live Ent.)
- Approved the application from **Y & J Choi, Inc.** for the transfer of the business and Retail General license of **CYH, Inc. (dba 21 Mart)** at 1135 N. School St. In a related matter, the Commission approved the application from **Y & J Choi, Inc. (dba 21 Mart)** for a Temporary Retail General license.
- Approved the application from **OCK Corporation. (dba Club Business)** at 1346 Kapiolani Blvd., for a 60-day renewal of its Temporary Dispenser General License (Cat. 4 – Hostess).
- Approved the application from **BMT, Inc. (dba Cooke Street Bar & Grill)** (Dispenser General license, Cat. 3 & 4 – Live Ent. & Hostess) at 614 Cooke St. for the transfer of capital stock and notification of new officer, director and stockholder.

During the other business portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Heard a three-month probationary status report on **Ja Ja Inc. (dba Club Asia nka Sky Lounge).**
The Commission terminated the licensee’s probation.
