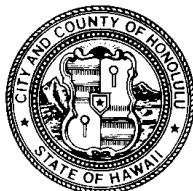

Commission Fines New Seven Kings For Fondling Violation

- Commission also fines Hatsuhana Restaurant, Masa's Market & Drive In, Haleiwa Chevron, Keo Enterprises, Inc. and The Garlic Restaurant Ninnikuya for selling liquor to minors –

HONOLULU (March 14, 2008) – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 35th meeting of the fiscal year on March 13, 2008.

- **Club Business** (no contest) was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-91, HRS (failing to comply with a Commission Order to produce records). In addition, the Commission ordered the licensee to reconstruct the records going back one more year to 2005 and to provide those to the Commission within three months of the date of the order.
- **Coyote Nights** (found guilty) was fined \$500 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(2), HRS (permitting liquor to be consumed on the premises, to wit, in the area outside of the entrance, in an area that is not permitted by the terms of the license). In addition, the premises will be monitored for three months by HLC investigative staff.
- **Hatsuhana Restaurant** (no contest) was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor).
- **Masa's Market & Drive In** (no contest), **Haleiwa Chevron** (no contest), and **Keo Enterprises, Inc.** (no contest) each were fined \$750 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor).
- **The Garlic Restaurant Ninnikuya** (found guilty) was fined \$500 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor).
- **Moana-Surfrider Hotel** (no contest) did not receive a fine for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor). However, the licensee was ordered to make their server training program available to other licensees if they request.
- The adjudications against **Hilton Hawaiian Village** and **7-Eleven Stores No. 54263** for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor) were continued until March 27, 2008 and April 3, 2008, respectively.

- **New Seven Kings** (no contest) was fined \$1,000 for violation of Rule 3-84-78.042 (fondling) and \$300 for violation of Rule 3-84-78.01(b) (employee consumption of liquor while on duty).
- The adjudication against **Saigon Passion III** for violation of Rule 3-84-78.042 (fondling) was continued until April 10, 2008.

During the public hearings portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **SCY Corporation** for the transfer of the business and Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 4 – Hostess) of **Mylynh Inc.** (dba **Mylynh’s Sports Bar & Restaurant**) at 835 Keeaumoku St, and for a change of trade name from **SCY Corporation** to **Next Door Bar & Grill**.
- Approved the application from **New Migawon, Inc.** for the transfer of the business and Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 1 – Standard Bar) of **Great Island Corp.** (dba **Mi Ka Won Restaurant**) at 1726 Kapiolani Blvd., Suite 1A and for a change of trade name to **New Migawon, Inc.**
- Approved the application from **Paesano at Waimalu LLC** for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 1 – Standard Bar) at 98-1277 Kaahumanu St. (**Waimalu Plaza Shopping Center**).
- Approved the application from **Gary’s At Harbor Court, LLC** for a Retail General license at 55 Merchant St., Suite 140.
- Cancelled the public hearing regarding the application from **Hawaii Theatre Center** for a Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 3 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 1130 Bethel St.

During the preliminary hearings, license and requests portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Ploi Thai, LLC** for a Special Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 327 Keawe St., Suite 5-327 on April 4, 2008. In a related matter, the Commission approved a request to have a casino night on April 4, 2008.
- Approved the application from **Bill El Gato Inc.** (dba **Cisco’s Cantina**) for a change of category from a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 1 – Standard Bar) to a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing).
- Approved the application from **Slow Down Town LLC** (dba **Downtown**) for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 250 South Hotel St.
- Approved the request from **Chambers & Chambers, Inc.** to permanently extend its licensed premises into an adjoining unit and to alter its existing premises at 501 Kokea St., Unit A-1/A-2.
- Approved the request from **Michael Wilson**, on behalf of **Tiki Corporation Ltd.** (dba **Aloha Lounge**) for permission to continue to exercise its Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 3 – Live entertainment or recorded Music and Dancing) at 3435 Waialae Ave. for the purpose of closing the affairs of the sole officer,

director, and shareholder of the corporation pursuant to HRS 281-95. In addition, the Commission requested Mr. Wilson to submit documentation establishing his status as survivor as soon as practicable.

During the Other Business portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Asked that the discussion regarding interpretation of HRS 281-17(a)(3) and -17.5 be placed on the agenda for the March 20, 2008 HLC hearing.
