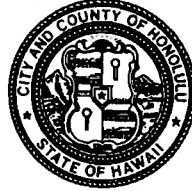

**Commission Suspends Licenses For Moose McGillicuddy's Pub & Café and Siam Garden Café  
HONOLULU (March 28, 2008)**

The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 37<sup>th</sup> meeting of the fiscal year on March 27, 2008.

- **Moose McGillicuddy's Pub & Cafe** (no contest) received a 30-day license suspension followed by a three-month probation) for multiple violations including violation of Rule 3-84-78.51(a) (promoting the excessive consumption of liquor by selling or offering to sell liquor to a person who appeared to be intoxicated), violation of Section 281-102.5(a) (licensee purchased or received liquor for resale from a source other than the primary source of supply for the brand of liquor sold), violation of Rule 3-82-38.3 (licensee permitted the preparation of drinks in such a manner that the customer did not have a clear and unobstructed view of the bartender's operations), two violations of Rule 3-84-78.52 (stacking), violation of Section 281-78(b)(6), HRS (licensee failed to prevent or suppress unlawful conduct of any person on the licensed premises), violation of Rule 3-84-78.042 (fondling), and two violations of Rule 3-82-38.5(a) (non-registered employee). In addition, the city withdrew the adjudications for violation of Section 281-78.5(a), HRS (licensee engaged in practices which promoted excessive consumption of liquor), and violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(B), HRS (licensee served liquor to a person who was at the time under the influence of liquor).
- **Club Fire and Ice** (guilty) was fined \$750 for a repeat violation of Rule 3-84-78.01(b) (employee consumption of liquor while on duty).
- **O'Toole's Irish Pub** (no contest) was fined \$200 for violation of Rule 3-84-78.03(b) (disturbance of the peace).
- **Bikini Cantina L.L.C.** (no contest) was fined \$2,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to minors). The Commission suspended \$1,000 of the fine provided the licensee does not receive a similar violation during the next year.

- **Hilton Hawaiian Village** (no contest) was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to minors). The commission suspended \$500 of the fine provided the licensee does not receive a similar violation during the next year.
- The adjudication against **Paradiso Seafood & Grille** for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to minors) was continued until April 3, 2008.
- **Lisa's House** (no contest) was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to minors).
- **Siam Garden Café** (no contest) received a two-month license suspension and the Commission ordered server training for the owners and managers within 20 days, monitoring of the premises by HLC enforcement for three months, and the reimbursement of \$545 in petty cash used for covert operations on the premises for multiple violations including violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(B), HRS (allowing the consumption of liquor by a person who was at the time under the influence of liquor), five violations of Rule 3-84-78.01(b) (employee consumption of liquor while on duty) four violations of Rule 3-84-78.01(c)(employee solicited or accepted food or beverage as a gift from or at the expense of a customer while on duty at the licensed premises), four violations of Rule 3-84-78.01(d) (employee was seated with a customer but was not a registered hostess or manager on duty of licensed premises), violation of Rule 3-82-38.3 (licensee permitted the preparation of drinks in such a manner that the customer did not have a clear and unobstructed view of the bartender's operations), violation of Rule 3-82-31.2(a) (licensee conducted business outside of the class or category authorized by the Commission), and two violations of Rule 3-84-78.01(b)(employee consumption of liquor while on duty).
- The adjudication against **Club Ariake** for violation of Section 281-41(i), HRS (licensee, without Commission approval, transferred the licensee's business) was continued until April 3, 2008.

During the public hearings portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Grace Lee** for the transfer of the business and Retail General license of **Waikiki Beach Market, LLC** at 410 Nahua Ave.
- Approved the application from **RMPG Industries Inc.** for the transfer of the business and Restaurant Beer and Wine License (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) of **Ken Wilson Sports Enterprises, Inc.** (dba **Mama's Island Pizza**) at 108 Kehili St., Suite 107.
- Approved the application from **Y & J Choi, Inc.** for the transfer of the business and Retail General license of **CYH, Inc.** (dba **21 Mart**) at 1135 North School St.
- Approved the application from **Hanabi Restaurant, Inc.** for the transfer of the business and Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) of **Bamboo**

**International, Inc.** (dba **Japanese Kitchen**) at 2700 South King St, #D and for a change of trade name to Hanabi Restaurant, Inc.

- Approved the application from **Hoku's Island, Inc.** for the transfer of the business and Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) of **Shiso-Zen, Inc.** at 20 Kainehe St, and for a change of trade name to **Hoku's Island, Inc.**
- Approved the application from **Rick's Restaurants Ltd.** (dba **Tanaka of Tokyo West**) for a change of location from 1777 Ala Moana Blvd. to 1450 Ala Moana Blvd., Stores 3235 and 3237 (**Ala Moana Center**).
- Approved the application from **Kapolei Italian Restaurant Inc.** (dba **Assaggio Kapolei**) for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 - Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 777 Kamokila Blvd.

During the preliminary hearings, license and requests portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved application from **J.H. Yi, Inc.** for the transfer of the business and Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 4 – Hostess) of **Chae Howard, Inc.** (dba **Club My Place**) at 1311 N. King St., and of a change of trade name to **J.H. Yi, Inc.** The Commission also approved a Temporary Dispenser General license.
- Approved the application from **JS Sorasowon Corp.** for the transfer of the business and Retail General license of **J.S. Atlas Inc.** (dba **Harry's Liquor**) at 1101 Waimanu St. and for a change of trade name to **Harry's Liquor Groceries.** The Commission also approved a Temporary Retail General license.
- Continued until April 3, 2008 the application from **JN & RB, Inc.** (dba **Sky Lounge**) for renewal of its Temporary Dispenser General license (Cat. No 3 and 4 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing; and Hostess).
- Approved the application from **Toraji Hawaii Corporation** (dba **Yakiniku Toraji**) for approval of the transfer of corporate stock and notification of new officer, director and stockholder.
- Approved the request from **MNS, Ltd.** (dba **ABC Store No. 31A**) to extend its approved licensed premises at 2233 Kalakaua Ave., Space B110A.
- Continued until April 3, 2008, the request from **M.T.B., LLC** (dba **Kochi/Gulick Deli**) to restore its Restaurant General license to a (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) license.
