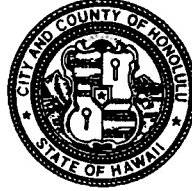

**Commission Suspends Fines for Paradiso Seafood & Grill, The O Lounge, Café Che Pasta,
Hideaway Café, 7-Eleven Stores No. 54263, 7-Eleven Stores No. 54135 and Michele's at the Colony Surf
- The O Lounge also placed on a three-month probation -**

HONOLULU (April 4, 2008) – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 38th meeting of the fiscal year on April 3, 2008.

- **Paradiso Seafood & Grille** (no contest) was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor). The Commission suspended \$250 of the fine provided the licensee does not receive a similar violation during the next year.
- **The O Lounge** (no contest) was fined a total of \$2,000 for two violations of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor). The Commission suspended \$250 of one of the fines provided the licensee does not receive a similar violation during the next year. The Commission also placed the licensee on a three-month probation.
- **Café Che Pasta** (no contest) was fined \$2,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor). The Commission suspended \$1,000 of the fine provided the licensee does not receive a similar violation during the next year. Another adjudication against the licensee was withdrawn and changed to a warning for violation of Rule 3-82-38.9(a) (failing to have a registered manager or assistant manager in active charge of the licensed premises).
- The adjudication against **Club Ariake** for violation of Section 281-41(i), HRS (licensee, without Commission approval, transferred the licensee's business) was continued until April 17, 2008.
- **Hideaway Café** (guilty) was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor). The Commission suspended \$250 of the fine provided the licensee does not receive a similar violation during the next year.
- **7-Eleven Stores No. 54263** was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor). The Commission suspended the fine provided the licensee installs an I.D. reading machine within

three months of the date of the order. In addition, the licensee must submit a receipt showing the purchase price of the I.D. reading machine to be at least \$1,000.

- **7-Eleven Stores No. 54135** was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor). The Commission suspended \$250 of the fine provided the licensee does not receive a similar violation during the next year. The Commission would suspend the entire fine provided the licensee installs an I.D. reading machine within three months of the date of the order, and submits a receipt showing the purchase price of the I.D. reading machine to be at least \$1,000.
- **Michel's at the Colony Surf** (guilty) was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor).

During the public hearing portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **ScandinAsian Restaurant Group LLC** (dba **Tango contemporary café**) for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 1288 Ala Moana Blvd., Suite 120 (**Hokua** condominium project).

During the preliminary hearings, license and requests portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Hae Sung Corporation** for the transfer of the business and Retail General license of **Earnest E. Byon, Inc.** (dba **Speed Mart**) at 407 Seaside Ave.
- Approved the application from **Suh Enterprises, Inc.** for the transfer of the business and Retail General license of Yung Hee Han (dba Pearl City Market) at 909 Lehua Ave. In a related matter, the Commission continued until April 17, 2008 the application for a Temporary Retail General license.
- Approved the application from **DS International Inc.** for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 1 – Standard Bar) at 510 Piikoi St.
- Approved the application from **Jinon Corporation** (dba **Nijiya Market**) for a Retail General license at 1009 University Ave., Suites No. MP-1, MP-4A and MP-4B (**Moilili Plaza; Puck's Alley**).
- Approved the application from **KMLEE Incorporated** (dba **Waimalu Supermarket**) for a Retail General license at 98-020 Kamehameha Hwy. (**Waimalu Shopping Center**). In a related matter, the Commission approved a Temporary Retail General license.
- Approved the application from **JN & RB, Inc.** (dba **Sky Lounge**) for renewal of its Temporary Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 3 and 4 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing; and Hostess) at 1362 A Kapiolani Blvd.
- Denied the request from **M.T.B., LLC** (dba **Kochi/Gulick Deli**) to restore its Restaurant General license to a (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) license.
