**Commission Fines Chiba-Ken, 1 2 3 Store, Ku ‘Ai Market-02, Nimitz Chevron  
and Yakiniku Hiroshi For Selling Liquor To Minors**

- **Commission suspends 15 days of the 30-day license suspension for Moose McGillycuddy’s Pub & Cafe - HONOLULU (April 18, 2008)** – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 40<sup>th</sup> meeting of the fiscal year on April 17, 2008.

- **Club Lagoon 500** (no contest) was fined \$250 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.4(b) (time card).
- **Cheesecake Factory** (no contest) was fined \$350 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.9(a) (failing to have duly registered manager or assistant manager in active charge of the licensed premises) and fined \$250 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.5(a) (non-registered employee).
- The adjudication against **Club Ariake** for violation of Section 281-41(i), HRS (licensee, without Commission approval, transferred the licensee’s business) was continued until the next available setting after May19, 2008.
- **Futaba Restaurant and Catering** entered a not guilty plea for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor) and the Commission continued the adjudication until the next available setting.
- **Chiba-Ken** (no contest), **1 2 3 Store** (no contest), **Ku ‘Ai Market-02** (no contest), **Nimitz Chevron** (no contest) and **Yakiniku Hiroshi** (no contest) each were fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor).

During the public hearings portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **JS Sorasowon Corp.** for the transfer of the business and Retail General license of **J.S. Atlas Inc. (dba Harry’s Liquor)** at 1101 Waimanu St., and for a change of trade name to **Harry’s Liquor Groceries.**
- Approved the application from **Ploi Thai, LLC (dba Ploi Thai Restaurant)** for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing).

During the preliminary hearings, license and requests portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Angeline Van Ngo** for the transfer of the business and Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) of **Binh Phuong Do** (dba **Indochine Café**) at 42 N. Hotel St. The Commission also approved a Temporary Restaurant General license.
- Continued the application until April 24, 2008 from **House of Wo Fat LLC** (dba **Loft Gallery Lounge**) for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing at 115 North Hotel St.).
- Approved the application from **Agustin Cardenas Torres** (dba **Mexico Restaurant**) for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 1247 North School St.
- Continued until April 24, 2008 the application from **Suh Enterprises, Inc.** for a Temporary Retail General license at 909 Lehua Ave., the present site of **Pearl City Market**.
- Approved the application from **Sodexo Management, Inc.** for a Caterer license to cater off the licensed premises to **Andrews Outdoor Theatre** (fka **Andrews Amphitheatre; University of Hawaii at Manoa**) on April 25 and 26, 2008. The Commission also requested the licensee to submit an event security plan and meet with HLC enforcement prior to the event, and a present a post-event report on May 8, 2008.
- Approved the application from **Kim Nguyen, LLC** (dba **New Sandy & Jen's**, nka **Club New Saigon Nights**) for the notification of new member at 1400 Kapiolani Blvd., #C-11.
- Approved the request from **Host International Inc.** and **GRL Corp.** (dba **Host Honolulu Joint Venture Company – Central Concourse Bar**) to alter and permanently extend its existing premises at **Honolulu International Airport**.

During the Other Business portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Granted a motion from **Moose McGillycuddy's Pub & Café** to reopen an adjudication hearing to hear additional evidence on penalty phase. The Commission then stated the original 30-day license suspension stands but suspended 15 days of the penalty while reserving the right to reinstate the second 15 days if further violations occur. In addition, the Commission extended the three-month probation to six months and ordered the probation to start April 17, 2008.
- Conferred with the Liquor Administrator in executive session regarding personnel and employment matters, in accordance with HRS 92-5(a)(2).
