Commission Fines Dos Cholos, Golden Pond, Mokauea Store, Sushi Koh, Food Pantry, Town Pump Liquors, Waimalu Gourmet Liquor and Benihana of Tokyo For Selling Liquor To Minors

- Holokai Grill, Par 3 Liquors and Samstco Discount Store also fined for employee registration violations -

HONOLULU (April 25, 2008) – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 41st meeting of the fiscal year on April 24, 2008.

- **Holokai Grill** (no contest) was fined \$350 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.9(a) (failing to have a registered manager or assistant manager in active charge of the licensed premises).
- **Par 3 Liquors** (no contest) and **Samstco Discount Store** (default) each were fined \$350 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.9(a)(2) (failing to have a registered manager or assistant manager assigned to the licensed premises).
- **Dos Cholos** (no contest), **Golden Pond** (no contest), **Mokauea Store** (no contest), **Sushi Koh** (no contest) each were fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor). In addition, the Commission suspended \$250 of each of the fines provided the licensees did not have a repeat violation within one year.
- **Food Pantry** (no contest), **Town Pump Liquors** (no contest) and **Waimalu Gourmet Liquor** (no contest) each were fined \$1,000 for violations of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor).
- **Benihana of Tokyo** (no contest) was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor). In addition, the Commission suspended \$500 of the fine provided the licensee did not have a repeat violation within one year.

During the public hearings portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Left the public hearing open and continued the hearing until May 1, 2008 from **Hae Sung Corporation** for the transfer of the business and Retail General license of **Earnest E. Byon, Inc.** (dba **Speed Mart**) at 407 Seaside Ave.
- Left the public hearing open and continued the hearing until May 1, 2008 from **Suh Enterprises, Inc.** for the transfer of the business and Retail General license of **Yung Hee Han** (dba **Pearl City Market**) at 909

Lehua Ave. The Commission also continued until May 1, 2008 the application for a Temporary Retail General license.

During the preliminary hearing portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Continued the application until May 8, 2008 from **House of Wo Fat LLC** (dba **Loft Gallery Lounge**) for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 115 North Hotel St.
