Commission Fines Alley Cat, Samstco Discount Store and Hawaiian Monarch Hotel For Violations HONOLULU (May 23, 2008) – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 45th meeting of the fiscal year on May 22, 2008.

- **Alley Cat** (default) was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-91, HRS (failing to comply with a Commission Order to pay a penalty of \$500 within 15 days of the date of service – Jan. 13, 2005). The City withdrew a similar charge regarding an Order dated Sept. 27, 2007.
- The adjudications against **Fashion 45** for violation of Rule 3-82-38.15(a)(licensee denied its male patrons the full and equal enjoyment of the facilities on the basis of sex, to wit, allowing free access to female patrons and charging male patrons on entrance fee) and for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor) were continued until June 19, 2008.
- **Samstco Discount Store** (guilty) was fined \$500 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.20(a) (permitting the sale of liquor within the licensed premises after the hours established by the Commission, to wit, 12:35 a.m.).
- **Hawaiian Monarch Hotel** (no contest) was fined \$500 for violation of Section 281-31(p), HRS (purchasing, acquiring or selling liquor which the licensee purchased or acquired from a person or entity other than a licensed wholesaler).
- The adjudication against **Mad Dog Saloon** for violation of Section 281-78(b)(6), HRS (licensee failed to immediately prevent or suppress any violent or unlawful conduct of any person on the premises when licensee's employees were involved in confrontations and/or altercations with various individuals) was continued to the next available setting after June 12, 2008.
- The adjudication against **Pachinco Karaoke/Venus Nightclub** for violation of Section 281-102.5(a) (purchased or received liquor for resale from a source other than the primary source of supply of the brand of liquor sought to be sold) was continued until May 29, 2008.
