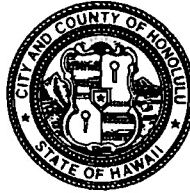

**Commission fines Fashion 45 and Mad Dog Saloon and places both establishments on probation**

**- Commission also fines Club Sun, Yakiniku Toraji, Club Chance and Dancers for violations -**

**- Hawaii Theatre Center also receives license in public hearing -**

**HONOLULU (June 20, 2008)** – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 49<sup>th</sup> meeting of the fiscal year on June 19, 2008.

- **Club Sun** pled no contest and was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-91, HRS (failing to comply with the portion of a Commission Order requiring Licensee to produce records).
- **Yakiniku Toraji** admitted the violation and was fined \$350 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.9(a) (failing to have a duly registered manager or assistant manager in active charge of the licensed premises).
- **Club Chance** pled no contest and was fined \$300 for violation of Rule 3-84-78.01(b) (employee consumption of liquor while on duty).
- **Dancers** pled no contest and was fined a total of \$1,000 for two violations of Rule 3-84-78.02(b) (lap dancing) and fined a total of \$600 for two violations of Rule 3-84-78.01(b) (employee consumption of liquor while on duty).
- **Fashion 45** pled no contest and was fined \$250 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.15(a) (denied male patrons the full and equal enjoyment of the Licensee's facilities, to wit, allowing female patrons free access) and fined a total of \$4,000 for two violations of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling liquor to a minor). In addition, the Commission placed the Licensee on probation for six months.
- The Commission sustained the violation against **Mad Dog Saloon** and fined the licensee \$2,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(6), HRS (failing to immediately prevent or suppress any violent, quarrelsome, disorderly, lewd immoral, or unlawful conduct of any person on the premises when the Licensee's employees were involved in confrontations and/or altercations with various individuals). In addition, the Commission placed the licensee on probation and requested HPD and HLC enforcement officers to regularly monitor the establishment.

During the public hearing portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Hawaii Theatre Center** for a Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 3 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 1130 Bethel Street.

During the preliminary hearings, license and request portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Continued until July 10, 2008, the application from **Henry Cheng LLC** for the transfer of the business and Restaurant Beer and Wine license (Cat. No. 1 – Standard Bar) of **Ginger House Restaurant, LLC** at 95-1249 Meheula Parkway, D-10 and for a change of trade name to **Ginger House**.
- Continued until August 14, 2008, the application from **Hawaii Hotel Services 2, Inc.** for a Hotel General license at 1775 Ala Moana Blvd.
- Approved the application from **Shamrock Brothers, LLC** (dba **J.J. Dolan's**) for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 1149 Bethel St.
- Approved the application from **PC Services, Inc.** (dba **Paradise Cove Luau**) for the transfer of capital stock and notification of new stockholder.
- Approved the application from **Welakahao Catamaran, Inc.** (dba **Outrigger Catamaran**) for the transfer of capital stock and notification of new officers, director and stockholder.
- Approved the request from **F.L. Inc.** (dba **Don Ho's Island Grill**) to temporarily extend its licensed premises from 2 p.m. on July 3, 2008 to 2 a.m. on July 4, 2008. In addition, the Commission requested the licensee to meet with HLC enforcement officers prior to the event to discuss security.
- Approved the request from **Don Quijote (USA) Co., Ltd.** (dba **Don Quijote** at 801 Kaheka St.) to acquire a total of 75 cases of Sapporo Yebisu Beer from **Don Quijote** at 345 Hahani St. and **Don Quijote/Oriental Seafoods** at 94-144 Farrington Hwy.

During the Other Business portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Continued until July 10, 2008 the hearing of the three-month probationary status report from **Next Door Partners LLC**.
