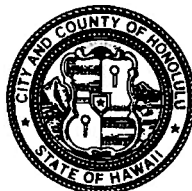

Commission suspends liquor license of Fashion 45 for four weeks

- Club Golden Gate also fined \$1,850 for three violations -

HONOLULU (July 25, 2008) – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its third meeting of the fiscal year on July 24, 2008.

- **Club Golden Gate** pled no contest and was fined a total of \$1,500 for two violations of Rule 3-84-7.01(b) (employee consumption of liquor) and fined \$350 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.4(b) (time card). The Commission also dismissed a charge regarding the violation of Rule 3-82-38.5(i) (employing a hostess without the employee completing server-training program).
- The adjudications against **The O Lounge** for three violations of 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to minors), for violation of Rule 3-84-78.52 (stacking) and for violation of Rule 3-81-17.54(d) (failing to make readily available for inspection its books and records for the last four years) were continued until Aug. 14, 2008.
- **Fashion 45** plead no contest for two violations of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (licensee sold, served or furnished intoxicating liquor to a minor). The Commission gave the licensee a four week license suspension but suspended one week, reserving the right to reinstate the one week if the licensee received additional violations.
- The adjudication against **Club Komo Mai** for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (licensee sold, served or furnished intoxicating liquor to a minor) was continued until Aug. 7, 2008.

During the public hearing portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Hawaiian Pau Hana's L.L.C.** for the transfer of the business and Cabaret General license of **Ocean Club, Limited Partnership**, (dba **Ocean Club**) at 500 Ala Moana Blvd. and for a change of trade name to **Hawaiian Pau Hana's L.L.C.**

During the preliminary hearings, license and request portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Cho White, Inc.** for the transfer of the business and Retail General license of **Makiki Food Center, Inc.** at 1433 Kinau St. and for a change of trade name to **Makiki Liquor Store**. The Commission also approved a Temporary Retail General license. In addition, the Commission approved a related request from **Makiki Food Center, Inc.** to make permanent extensions and alterations to the licensed premises.
- Approved the application from **D'Vine Fine Wines and Spirits LLC** for a Retail General license at 7192 Kalaniana'ole Hwy., Suite C-122 (**Koko Marina Shopping Center**).
- Approved the application from **Raja Baja, Inc.** (dba **Taco Del Mar**) for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 1 – Standard Bar) at 46-056 Kamehameha Hwy, Space G-10 (**Windward Mall**).
- Approved the application from **EHW-II, LLC** (dba **Harbor Court Bistro**) for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 66 Queen Street, Suite 20. The Commission also a Stand-Alone Temporary Restaurant General license.
- Approved the application from **AM Jewell, Inc.** (dba **Club Texas**) for the transfer of capital stock and notification of new officer, director and stockholder.
- Approved the application from **J.H. Yi, Inc.** (dba **Kools Lounge**) for the transfer of capital stock and notification of new officers, directors and stockholder.
- Continued the application from **Peninsula Corp.** (dba **Akasaka Restaurant**) for transfer of capital stock and notification of new stockholder until July 31, 2008.
- Approved the acceptance of an application for an extended Caterer License from **The Shack Mililani LLC** at 95-221 Kipapa Dr. The Caterer License application will be placed on the July 31, 2008 agenda.
