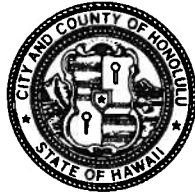

Commission fines Pearl Kai Mini Mart, Nanko Inc., A Stop Convenience Store, and Club Bunny Girls HONOLULU (Aug. 4, 2008) – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its fourth meeting of the fiscal year on July 31, 2008.

- Continued the adjudications until Aug. 21, 2008 against **Happiness Lounge** for two violations of Rule 3-82-38.5(i) (failing to ensure employee was registered as a hostess while performing duties of a hostess), for two violations of Rule 3-82-38.4(a) (time card), and for two violations of 3-84-78.01(c) (employee solicited or accepted food or beverage as a gift from or at the expense of a customer while on duty at the licensed premises).
- **Pearl Kai Mini Mart** (no contest), **Nanko Inc.** (no contest), and **A Stop Convenience Store** (no contest) each were fined \$350 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.9(a)(2) (failing to have a registered manager or assistant manager assigned to the licensed premises).
- **Club Bunny Girls** (no contest) was fined \$300 for violation of Rule 3-84-78.01(b)(employee consumption of liquor while on duty).

During the public hearings portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **K & E 909, Inc.** (dba **909 Mini Mart**) for a Retail General license at 909 Kapiolani Blvd., Suite C-D.
- Approved the application from **JJ Kang Inc.** (dba **Kapalama School St. Chevron**) for a Retail Beer and Wine license at 1402 North School St.

During the preliminary hearings, license and request portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **KG Restaurants Inc.** for the transfer of the business and Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) of **Luana Hills Restaurant, Inc.** at 770 Auloa Rd. and for a change of trade name to **KG Restaurants Inc.**
- Continued the application from **Uncha Tak** (dba **Red Meat Market**) for a Retail General license at 1270 North King St., Suite B until Aug. 14, 2008.

- Approved the application from **Waialae Bowl, Inc.** for a Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 3 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 4618 Kilauea Ave.
- Approved the application from **The Shack Mililani LLC** for a Caterer license to cater off the licensed premises to 2255 Kuhio Ave., Suite S-10 and S-11 (proposed site of **The Shack Waikiki**) for 60 days from Aug. 1. The licensee had originally requested the catering license to extend to Oct. 29, 2008. The Commission also requested a security plan.
- Approved the application from **JJKK, Inc.** (dba **Hello Eve**) for the transfer of capital stock and notification of new officer, director and stockholder at 1400 Kapiolani Blvd.
- Approved the application from **Peninsula Corp.** (dba **Akasaka Restaurant**) for the transfer of capital stock and notification of new stockholder at 1646 Kona St.
- Heard the Petition for Adoption, Amendment, or Repeal of Rules from **Club FNU, Inc.** (dba **Club Femme Nu**) and accepted the Petition for consideration but deleted the last sentence, which as written would absolve the licensee of responsibility for any penalty. The Rules Committee will consider the proposed rule during the next Rules amendment effort.

During the Other Business portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Heard a Motion for Reconsideration of the Liquor Commission's Denial of the Request from Robert H. Nakata, Esq., and/or Kenneth G. K. Hoo, Esq., on behalf of **TMNPS Corporation** (dba **Saigon Passion III**) for a waiver of Rule 3-82-31.4 and Rule 3-81-17.53 to be permitted to file an application for renewal of Cabaret General License No. I0029 for fiscal year 2008-2009, pursuant to Rule 3-81-17.8. The Commission granted the Reconsideration and granted the waiver, permitting the licensee to file its application for renewal.
