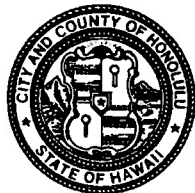

Senor Frog's receives \$4,500 in fines for liquor violations

- Commission also fines Club Casablanca, Nina Mini Mart, Kaneohe Market and J's Bar-B-Q -

HONOLULU (Aug. 8, 2008) – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its fifth meeting of the fiscal year on Aug. 7, 2008.

- **Club Casablanca** pled no contest and was fined \$250 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.5(a)(non-registered employee).
- **Nina Mini Mart** pled no contest and was fined \$350 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.9(a)(2)(failing to have a registered manager or assistant manager assigned to the licensed premises). The Commission suspended \$250 of the fine provided there are no violations during the next year.
- **Kaneohe Market** pled no contest and was fined \$350 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.9(a)(2)(failing to have a registered manager or assistant manager assigned to the licensed premises).
- **J's Bar-B-Q** pled no contest and was fined \$350 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.9(a)(2)(failing to have a registered manager or assistant manager assigned to the licensed premises).
- **Huali Market** pled no contest and was fined \$350 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.9(a)(2)(failing to have a registered manager or assistant manager assigned to the licensed premises). In addition, the Commission ruled that the licensee could no longer sell liquor until they comply with the registered manager Rule.
- The adjudication against **Club Komo Mai** for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor) was continued until Aug. 21, 2008.
- **Senor Frog's** pled no contest and was fined a total of \$4,000 for four violations of Section 281-78(b)(1)(B), HRS (selling, serving, furnishing or allowing consumption of liquor by a person who was at the time under the influence of liquor) and fined \$500 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(5), HRS (knowingly permitting a person who was under the influence of liquor to remain on the licensed premises).

During the public hearings portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Continued until Aug. 14, 2008, the application from **William Gladstone International Marketing, Inc.** (dba **William Gladstone Imports**) for a change of location from Pier 2, 521 Ala Moana Blvd. to 501 Sumner St., Suite 502.
- Approved the application from **Galaxy Steak House LLC** for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 2301 Kuhio Ave., Suite 201A (**Waikiki Town Center**).

During the preliminary hearings, license and request portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **H.F. Hawaii Enterprises, Inc.** (dba **Crouching Lion Inn**) for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing).
- Approved the application with a condition from **Meridian Sports Centers Hawaii, LLC** (dba **Honolulu Club**) for a Temporary Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 1 – Standard Bar) at 932 Ward Ave. The Commission placed a condition on the license per Rule 3-82-38.25, restricting liquor service/consumption to certain areas of the seventh floor as delineated in the floor plan and with signage and notices.
- Approved the application from **Okimoto Corp.** (dba **Waianae Store**) for approval of the transfer of capital stock and notification of new officers and stockholders at 85-863 Farrington Hwy.

During the Other Business portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved a motion from **Keith M. Kiuchi**, on behalf of **Tropics Café Bar and Lounge LLC**, for a waiver of Rule 3-82-31.4 to allow the late filing of the application to renew its liquor license and the late submission of its tax clearance certificate.
- Heard the HLC Administrator's review of the three-month probationary period for **Green Chateau, Inc.**(dba **Coyote Nights**) and terminated the probation status for the licensee.
- Conferred in executive session with the HLC Administrator regarding personnel and employment matters, in accordance with HRS 92-5(a)(2).
