**Club Tomorrow II (nka Club Tomorrow I) receives \$5,250 in fines for liquor violations**

**HONOLULU (Aug. 18, 2008)** – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its sixth meeting of the fiscal year on Aug. 14, 2008.

- **Club Tomorrow II (nka Club Tomorrow I)** pled no contest, was fined \$500 and ordered to provide the books and records within 90 days for violation of Rule 3-81-17.54(d) (failing to provide for inspection and/or auditing its books and records for the last four years). In addition, the Commission suspended \$250 of the fine if the licensee does provide the books and records within 90 days. Club Tomorrow II also was fined \$1,000 for violation of Rule 3-84-78.042 (fondling), fined a total of \$600 for two violations of Rule 3-84-78.01(b) (employee consumed liquor while on duty), fined \$250 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.5(a) (non-registered employee) and fined a total of \$3,750 for 15 violations of Rule 3-82-38.4 (time card).
- The adjudications against **The O Lounge** for three violations of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to minors), for violation of Rule 3-84-78.52 (stacking) and for violation of Rule 3-81-17.54(d) (failing to make readily available for inspection its books and records for the last four years) were continued until Aug. 21, 2008.
- **Lulu's Waikiki Surf** admitted to the violations and was fined a total of \$2,000 for two violations of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to minors), fined \$100 for violation of Rule 3-84-78.52 (stacking) and fined \$500 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(5) (knowingly permitting a person who was under the influence of liquor or disorderly person to be or remain in or on the licensed premises). The Commission will suspend a total of \$1,600 of the \$2,600 in fines if there are no violations at the licensed establishment for a period of one year.

During the public hearings portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Cho White, Inc.** for the transfer of the business and Retail General license of **Makiki Food Center, Inc.** at 1433 Kinau St. and for a change of trade name to **Makiki Liquor Store.**
