Honolulu Liquor Commission fines Exotic Nights, Airport 7 Market, Happy World Grocery, Goodies Market Inc., Diamond Head Market and Grill, Waikiki Shore Beach Shop and Valley Market HONOLULU (Sept. 2, 2008) – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its seventh meeting of the fiscal year on Aug. 28, 2008.

- **Exotic Nights** pled no contest and was fined a total of \$500 for two violation of Rule 3-82-38.5(a) (non-registered employee).
- **Airport 7 Market** (no contest), **Happy World Grocery** (no contest), **Goodies Market Inc.** (no contest), **Diamond Head Market and Grill** (no contest), **Waikiki Shore Beach Shop** (no contest) and **Valley Market** (no contest) each were fined \$350 for violation of rule 3-82-38.9(a)(2) (failing to have a duly registered manager or assistant manager assigned to the licensed premises).
- **Coconut Willy's Bar and Grill** pled no contest and received letters of reprimand for violations of Rule 3-82.38.23(b) (noise levels in excess of 50dBA and exceeding the ambient noise level by three or more decibels for a combined total of two minutes in any twenty minute period) and for violation of Rule 3-84-78.03(b) (disturbing the peace and quiet of the neighborhood).
