**Club Komo Mai and The O Lounge receive fines and are placed
on probation for six months for selling liquor to a minor
- Commission also fines Off the Wall Restaurant and Bar, Ige's Restaurant & 19th Puka
and Tadashi for selling liquor to minors -**

HONOLULU (Sept. 15, 2008) – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its eighth meeting of the fiscal year on Sept. 11, 2008.

- The Commission found that the City proved the allegations in the Notice of Hearing and fined **Club Komo Mai** \$2,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor). In addition, the Commission placed the licensee on probation for six months effective Sept. 11, 2008.
- **Royal Mini Mart** (no contest) was fined \$250 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.9(a)(2) (failing to have a duly registered manager or assistant manager assigned to the licensed premises).
- **Happiness Lounge** admitted the allegations and was fined a total of \$1,000 for two repeat violations of Rule 3-82-38.5(i) (failing to ensure its employee was duly registered as a hostess), fined a total of \$600 for two violations of Rule 3-82-38.4(a) (time card) and fined a total of \$200 for two violations of Rule 3-84-78.01(c) (employee solicited or accepted food or beverage as a gift from or at the expense of a customer while on duty on the licensed premises).
- **Black Stallion Lounge** pled no contest and was fined a total of \$3,000 for three violations of Rule 3-84-78.042 (fondling), fined a total of \$900 for three violations of Rule 3-84-78.01(b)(employee consumption of liquor while on duty), fined a total of \$500 for two violations of Rule 3-82-38.5(a)(non-registered employee), and fined a total of \$750 for three violations of Rule 3-82-38.4(b)(time card).
- Two charges were withdrawn against **The O Lounge** for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor). In addition, **The O Lounge** pled no contest and was fined a total of \$4,000 for two repeat violations of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor). The Commission also placed the licensee on probation for six months effective Sept. 11, 2008.

- **Off The Wall Restaurant and Bar, Ige's Restaurant & 19th Puka, LLC and Tadashi** each pled no contest and each received fines of \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor).

During the public hearing portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Tae Hi Mun** for the transfer of the business and Retail General license if **Sheila Nishimura (dba Corner Bay Market)** at 581 Dillingham Blvd. and for a change of trade name to **JB Mart**.

During the preliminary hearings, license and request portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Jinroku Corporation** for the transfer of the business and Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 4 – Hostess) of **Hitomi Corporation (dba Club Ai)** at 2427 Kuhio Ave. and for a change of trade name to **Jinroku Pacific**.
- Found there was good cause to transfer the license after less than one year's time and approved the application from **GDFT LLC** for the transfer of the business and Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) of **Tio's Garage & Taco LLC (dba Tio's – Garage & Taco Station)** at 404 Ward Ave. and for a change of trade name to **Kanpai Bar & Grill**. In addition, the Commission approved a Temporary Restaurant General license.
- Continued the application to Sept. 25, 2008 from **PC Pub, Inc.** for the transfer of the business and Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 4 – Hostess) of **Waterfall Lounge, Inc.** at 803 Kamehameha Hwy.
- Approved the request from **Pinky's Shrimp Bar & Grill, LLC (dba Pinky's Pupu Bar & Grill at Kailua)** for the transfer of membership interest and notification of admission of member at 970 North Kalaheo Ave.

During the Other Business portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Reviewed and approved the Delegation of Authority to Administrator pursuant to Rule 3-81-17.4.
