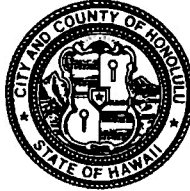

**Centerplate, Brew Moon Restaurant & Microbrewery, K & K Corner Mart, Odoriko Maiko Bekkan,
Arancino Di Mare and The Ground Floor Restaurant fined for selling liquor to minors**

- Valid written protests from registered voters also block liquor license for Harbor Court Bistro -

HONOLULU (Sept. 29, 2008) – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 11th meeting of the fiscal year on Sept. 25, 2008.

- The adjudication against **Honolulu Tavern** for violation of Rule 3-82-38.23(b) (noise) was continued until Dec. 4, 2008. Relating to the same licensee, the Commission continued to Dec. 4, 2008, a request to remove the common elements from the licensed premises and a request to cancel approval for installation of a karaoke system.
- **Centerplate** (no contest) was fined \$100 for violation of Rule 3-84-78.52 (stacking) and fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor).
- **Brew Moon Restaurant & Microbrewery (nka The Brew Moon, Ward Centre LLC)** (no contest) and was fined a total of \$4,000 for two violations of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor). In addition, the Commission issued a letter of reprimand to **The Brew Moon, Ward Centre LLC** for violation of Section 281-3, HRS (selling liquor without a valid license).
- **K & K Corner Mart** (no contest) was fined a total of \$2,000 for two violations of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor).
- **Odoriko Maiko Bekkan** admitted to the charge and was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor).
- **Arancino Di Mare** (no contest) and **The Ground Floor Restaurant** (no contest) each were fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor). In addition, the Commission suspended \$250 of both fines provided that the licensees did not have similar violations within the next year.

- The adjudication against **Hooters** for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor) was withdrawn and a warning will be issued.
- **Tondo-Tondo** pled no contest and the Commission continued the penalty phase until Oct. 9, 2008 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(B), HRS (selling, serving, furnishing or allowing consumption of liquor by a person under the influence), violation of Section 281-78.5(a), HRS (engaging in practices which promoted excessive consumption of liquor), violation of Rule 3-82-38.1 (licensee and employees failed to familiarize themselves with the liquor laws and the rules of the Commission), violation of Rule 3-82.38.5(a) (non-registered employee) violation of Rule 3-82-38.4(b) (time card), violation of Rule 3-84-78.01(b) (licensee's female employee consumed liquor while on duty on the licensed premises) and violation of Rule 3-84-78.52 (stacking).

During the public hearings portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **D'Vine Fine Wines and Spirits LLC** for a Retail General license at 7192 Kalaniana'ole Hwy., Suite C-122 (**Koko Marina Shopping Center**).
- Approved the application from **Raja Baja, Inc.** (dba **Taco Del Mar**) for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 1 – Standard Bar) at 46-056 Kamehameha Hwy. The Commission also approved the request for a waiver of Rule 3-81-17.58 requiring registration and submission of Certificate of Registration of Trade Name issued by the State Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs.
- Denied the applicant's request for a continuation and took no action (mandatory denial based upon number of valid protests from registered voters) on the application from **EHW-KK, LLC** (dba **Harbor Court Bistro**) for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 66 Queen St., Suite 20.
- Approved the application from **Wai'ala'e Bowl, Inc.** for a Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 3 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 4618 Kilauea Ave.

During the preliminary hearings, license and requests portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Meridian Sports Centers Hawaii, LLC** for the transfer of the business and Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 1 – Standard Bar) of **Honolulu Club Limited Partners** (dba **Honolulu Club**) at 932 Ward Ave. The Commission also approved a related request to permanently delete a portion of the licensed premises.
- Approved the application from **PC Pub, Inc.** for the transfer of the business and Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 4 – Hostess) of Waterfall Lounge, Inc. at 803 Kamehameha Hwy.
- Approved the application from **Hawaii Hotel Services 2 Inc.** for a Hotel General license at 1775 Ala Moana Blvd.

- Approved the application from **Sergio's Diamond Head, LLC** (dba **Sergio's Italian Restaurant**) for a Temporary Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 449 Kapahulu Ave., the current site of **Sam Choy's Diamond Head Restaurant**.
- Approved the application from **The Shack Mililani, LLC** for a Caterer license to cater off the licensed premises to 2255 Kuhio Ave, Suite S-10 and S-11 (proposed site of **The Shack Waikiki**) from Sept. 30 to Oct. 9, 2008.
