Honolulu Liquor Commission fines seven licensees for selling liquor to minors

- Commission also terminates probation for Siam Garden Café, Inc. -

HONOLULU (Oct. 17, 2008) – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 14th meeting of the fiscal year on Oct. 16, 2008.

- **Doraku Waikiki LLC** (admitted to the allegations), **Ocean Seafood and Steak House** (no contest), **Furusato Sushi** (no contest), **Waldo's Pizza** (no contest) and **Palace Buffet** (no contest) each were fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor).
- **Chili's Grill & Bar** (no contest) and **Henry Loui's** (no contest) each were fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor). In addition, the Commission suspended \$250 of each fine provided the licensees receive no similar violation within one year.

During the preliminary hearings, license and request portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **QSI, Inc.** for the transfer of the business and Retail General license of **Shimas Market Inc.** at 41-1606 Kalaniana'ole Hwy., and for a change of trade name to **Times Super Market**.
- Approved the application from **CB Beachwalk Inc.** for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 226 Lewers St., Space No. L-200.
- Continued the application from **Macoure, Inc.** (dba **Modern Kappo Miyabi**) for a Temporary Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 808 Kapahulu Ave. to a date to be determined later.
- Approved the application from **Yoshikai USA, Inc.** (dba **Bistro AUN**) for a Temporary Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 1960 Kapiolani Blvd., #107, the current site of **Ah Unn Restaurant, LLC**.
- Approved the application from **Pipeline Café, Inc.** for approval of the transfer of capital stock and notification of new officer, director and stockholder at 805 Pohukaina St.

- Approved the request from **F.L. Inc.** (dba **Don Ho's Island Grill**) to temporarily extend its licensed premises from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Oct. 24, 2008.
- Approved the request from **Restaurant One, Inc.** (dba **Tokoname Sushi Restaurant**) to permanently extend its licensed premises to include the outdoor dining area at 442 Uluniu St.

During the Other Business portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Continued until Oct. 23, 2008, a request from **William A. Harrison, Esq.**, on behalf of **Waimea Falls Grill, LLC**, a waiver of Rule 3-82-31.4 to allow for late filing of application to renew liquor license and late submission of tax clearance certificate.
- Reviewed the three-month probationary period for **Siam Garden Café, Inc.** and terminated the probation.
- Conferred with the Liquor Administrator in executive session regarding personnel and employment matters, in accordance with HRS 92-5(a)(2).
