**Honolulu Liquor Commission places Pachinco Karaoke/Venus Nightclub on probation**

**- Commission also fines Kinalau Mini-Mart, Moulin Rouge Night Club, Mangiamo! Italian**

**Restaurant, Embassy Suites Hotel-Waikiki Beach Walk, Town, and Aloha Lounge for violations -**

**HONOLULU (Oct. 31, 2008)** – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 16<sup>th</sup> meeting of the fiscal year on Oct. 30, 2008.

- **Kinalau Mini-Mart** (no contest) was fined \$350 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.9(a)(2) (failing to have a registered manager or assistant manager assigned to the licensed premises).
- **Moulin Rouge Night Club** (no contest) was fined a total of \$2,000 for two violations of Rule 3-84-78.042 (fondling), fined \$250 for violation of Rule 3-84-78.01(d) (employee seated with a customer was not a registered hostess or manager on duty of licensed premises) and fined \$250 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.5(a) (non-registered employee). Two violations of Rule 3-84.78.01(b) (employee consumption of liquor) were withdrawn.
- **Pachinco Karaoke/Venus Nightclub** (no contest) was fined a total of \$4,000 for two violations of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor). In addition, the Commission placed a three-month suspension on the licensee effective Oct. 30, 2008.
- **Mangiamo! Italian Restaurant** (no contest), **Embassy Suites Hotel-Waikiki Beach Walk** (no contest) and **Town** (no contest), each were fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor).
- **Aloha Lounge** (no contest) was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor). In addition, the Commission suspended \$250 of the fine provided the licensee receives no similar violation within one year.

During the public hearings portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Walgreen of Hawaii, LLC** for a Retail General license at 46-023 Kamehameha Hwy. (former site of **Star Market Kaneohe**).

- Approved the application from **Counter Kahala LLC** (dba **The Counter**) for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 4211 Waiālae Ave., Space No. E-2 (**Kahala Mall Shopping Center**).

During the request portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the requests from **Waiālae Country Club** for approval to accept dated Personal History and Affidavit for a Special License application yet to be filed; and to waive the requirement to submit Criminal History Record Clearance and Fingerprint Card for its officers and directors with the license application.
