**Honolulu Liquor Commission continues penalty phase regarding violation
by Moose McGillicuddy's Pub & Café while on probation**

Commission also fines Chin's Kahala, Inc., Princess Palace and Red Baron's Pizza for selling liquor to minors
HONOLULU (Nov. 7, 2008) – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 17th meeting of the fiscal year on Nov. 6, 2008.

- **Kazoku Sushi** (no contest) was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-3, HRS (unlicensed premise did sell liquor without having a valid 2008-2009 license to sell such liquor).
- **Moose McGillicuddy's Pub & Café** pled no contest to violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor). The Commission continued the penalty phase, and the reinstatement of a 15-day suspension from a prior similar violation, to Nov. 13, 2008. In a related matter, the Commission also continued until Nov. 13, 2008 the review of the six-month probationary period for the licensee.
- **Chin's Kahala, Inc.** (no contest) and **Princess Palace** (no contest) each were fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor).
- **Red Baron's Pizza** (no contest) was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor). In addition, the Commission suspended \$250 of the fine provided the licensee receives no similar violation within one year.

During the public hearings portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Jinroku Corporation** for the transfer of the business and Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 4 – Hostess) of **Hitomi Corporation** (dba **Club Ai**) at 2427 Kuhio Ave., and for a change of trade name to **Jinroku Pacific**.
- Approved the application from **QSI, Inc.** for the transfer of the business and Retail General license of **Shimas Market, Inc.** at 41-1606 Kalaniana'ole Hwy., and for a change of trade name to **Times Super Market**.

During the request portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the request from **E & J Operation Co., Inc.** (dba **O’Toole’s Irish Pub**) to permanently extend its licensed premises to include an adjacent building (**6 Marin Street**) and the common areas (courtyard and restrooms).
- Approved the request from **Cheeseburger in Paradise-Waikiki, a California Limited partnership**, to accept an application for extended Caterer License to the future site of **CB Boardwalk Inc.** (dba **CB Boardwalk Inc.**) at the Waikiki Beachwalk Project, Lewers St.
