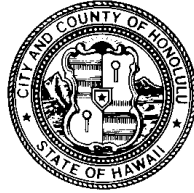

**Honolulu Liquor Commission suspends license of Moose McGillicuddy's Pub & Café for one day
and places the licensee on probation for an additional six months**

- Commission also places Senor Frog's on probation for six months for selling liquor to minors -

HONOLULU (Nov. 14, 2008) – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 18th meeting of the fiscal year on Nov. 13, 2008.

- **Club Pieces** (nka **1st Time**) (no contest) was fined a total of \$600 for two violations of Rule 3-84-78.01(b) (employee consumption of liquor while on duty), fined a total of \$3,000 for three violations of Rule 3-84-78.042 (fondling), fined \$250 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.4(b) (time card) and fined \$250 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.5(a) (non-registered employee). The Commission also withdrew one violation of Rule 3-82-38.5(a) (non-registered employee).
- **Moose McGillicuddy's Pub & Café** (pled no contest on Nov. 6, 2008) was fined \$2,000 and placed on a six-month probation for a violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor) while on probation. The Commission reinstated a one-day suspension from a previously adjudicated matter (Mar. 27, 2008 and Apr. 17, 2008), with the licensee permitted to choose the Friday it wished to serve the one-day suspension (the licensee selected Nov. 21, 2008).
- **Seaside Bar & Grill** (no contest) and **Happy Days Chinese Seafood Restaurant** (no contest) each were fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor).
- **Giovanni Pastrami** (no contest) was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor). In addition, the Commission suspended \$250 of the fine provided the licensee receives no similar violation within one year.
- **Senor Frog's** (no contest) was fined \$1,000 and placed on a six-month probation for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor).
- **Tanaka of Tokyo** (no contest) was fined \$500 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor).

- The Commission dismissed the charge against **Cattle Company Steakhouse** for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor).

During the public hearings portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Sergio's Diamond Head, LLC** for the transfer of the business and Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) of **Sam Choy's Diamond Head** at 449 Kapahulu Ave. and for a change of trade name to **Sergio's Italian Restaurant**.
- Approved the application from **Yoshikai USA, Inc.** for the transfer of the business and Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) of **Ah Uhn Restaurant, LLC** at 1960 Kapiolani Blvd. and for a change of trade name to **Bistro AUN**.

During the preliminary hearings, license applications and requests portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **1128 Building, LLC** (dba **L G W**) for a Special General license on Feb. 6, Feb. 24 and March 6, 2009.
- Approved the application from **Macuore, Inc.** for the transfer of the business and Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) of **Shigezo Hawaii, Inc.** (dba **808 Kapahulu**) at 808 Kapahulu Ave. and for a change of trade name to **Modern Kappo Miyabi**. The Commission also approved a Temporary Restaurant General license.
- Approved the application from **KOLL LLC** (dba **Nanea Hale**) for a Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 3 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 92-101 Waiali'i Place.
- Approved the application from **Silvert & Saibene Wines, LLP** for a Wholesale Beer and Wine license at 521 Ala Moana Blvd., Pier 2, Foreign Trade Zone 9.
- Approved the application from **Cheeseburger in Paradise – Waikiki, a California Limited Partnership** for a Caterer license to cater off the licensed premises to 226 Lewers St., Suite L200 (proposed site of **CB Beachwalk, Inc.**) from Nov. 17 to Dec. 12, 2008).
- Approved the application from **Sun Rising T.Y. Corp.** (dba **Bob's Market**) for approval of the transfer of capital stock and notification of new officer, director and stockholder at 1729 Liliha St.
- Approved requests from F.L. Inc. (**Don Ho's Island Grill**) to temporarily extend its licensed premises from 3 p.m. on Nov. 22 to 2 a.m. Nov. 23, 2008 and from 3 p.m. Dec. 31, 2008 to 2 a.m. Jan. 1, 2009. The Commission also requested the licensee to meet with HLC enforcement staff to go over security.

During the other business portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Reviewed and approved administrative duties delegated to the Administrator under Rule 3-81-17.4.
