Honolulu Liquor Commission fines Just Tacos Mexican Grill & Cantina, KMART #7478, Makino Chaya Aloha Inc., Makino Chaya Aiea Inc., Hawaii Yacht Club, Gyoza No Ohsho, Loulen's Restaurant and Hyung Je Joomooluck for gross liquor sales reporting violations
- Zippy's also fined for selling liquor to minors -

HONOLULU (Nov. 24, 2008) – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 19th meeting of the fiscal year on Nov. 20, 2008.

- **Zippy's** (pled no contest on Oct. 9, 2008) was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor).
- **Just Tacos Mexican Grill & Cantina** (no contest) was fined \$850 for failing to file a gross liquor sales report with the Commission on or before Sept. 2, 2008.
- **KMART #7478** (no contest) was fined \$550 for failing to file a gross liquor sales report with the Commission on or before Sept. 2, 2008.
- **Makino Chaya Aloha Inc.** (no contest) and **Makino Chaya Aiea Inc.** (no contest) each were fined \$400 for failing to file a gross liquor sales report with the Commission on or before Sept. 2, 2008.
- **Ko Olina Cat** (no contest) was fined \$275 for failing to file a gross liquor sales report with the Commission on or before Sept. 2, 2008.
- **Hyung Je Joomooluck** (no contest), **Hawaii Yacht Club** (no contest), **Gyoza No Ohsho** (no contest) and **Loulen's** (no contest) were each fined \$250 for failing to file a gross liquor sales report with the Commission on or before Sept. 2, 2008.
- The adjudication against **Hawaiian Steakhouse & Bar** for failing to file a gross liquor sales report with the Commission on or before Sept. 2, 2008 was continued to the next available setting.

During the public hearings portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Meridian Sports Centers Hawaii, LLC** for the transfer of the business and Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 1 – Standard Bar) of **Honolulu Club Limited Partners (dba Honolulu Club)** at 932 Ward Ave.
- Approved the application from **PC Pub, Inc.** for the transfer of the business and Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 4 – Hostess) of **Waterfall Lounge, Inc.** at 803 Kamehameha Hwy.
- Continued until February 5, 2009, the application from **Hawaii Hotel Services 2 Inc.** for a Hotel General license at 1775 Ala Moana Blvd. The Commission left the public hearing open and letters of support or protests will be accepted until Jan. 29, 2009.
- Continued until Dec. 11, 2008 the application from **Jungle Juice Market LLC** for a Retail General license at 95-020 Waihau St. The Commission left the public hearing open and requested the applicant to develop a business plan and to reach out to the community regarding its compliance concerns.
- Approved the application from **Jimmy Buffett's at the Beachcomber, LLC** for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing).
- Approved the application from **Hajime Investments LLC (dba Maile's Thai Bistro)** for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 1 – Standard Bar) at 333 Keahole St., No. 2B8 (**Hawaii Kai Towne Center**).
- Continued until Dec. 4, 2008, the application from **Office Gaia, LLC (dba Live 99)** for a Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 3 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 1272 South King St. The Commission closed the public hearing and will have HLC staff verify the protests.
