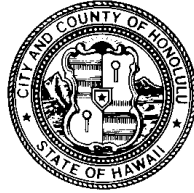

**Honolulu Liquor Commission fines Downtown Market, Lucy's Grill N' Bar, Chili's Grill & Bar, Frog House Restaurant, The Piano, Zia's Café and Restaurant Epic**

**HONOLULU (Dec. 5, 2008)** – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 20<sup>th</sup> meeting of the fiscal year on Dec. 4, 2008.

- **Downtown Market** admitted to the allegations and was fined \$350 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.99a)(2) (failing to have a duly registered manager assigned to the licensed premises). The Commission suspended \$100 of the fine.
- The adjudication against **Honolulu Tavern** for violation of Rule 3-82-38.23(b) (noise) was continued until Dec. 18, 2008. Relating to the same licensee, the Commission continued to Dec. 18, 2008, a request to remove the common elements from the licensed premises and a request to cancel approval for installation of a karaoke system.
- **Lucy's Grill N' Bar** admitted to the allegations and was fined \$1,000 for violation of Rule 3-84-79.1 (obstructing, hampering or interfering with investigations or Commission operations) and fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor).
- The charge against **Pane & Vino** was withdrawn and a warning issued for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor).
- **Chili's Grill & Bar** admitted to the allegations and was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor). The Commission suspended \$250 of the fine provided the licensee not receive a similar violation within one year.
- **Frog House Restaurant** (no contest) and **The Piano** (no contest) each were fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor).
- **Zia's Café** (no contest) was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor). The Commission suspended \$250 of the fine provided the licensee not receive a similar violation within one year.

- **Restaurant Epic** (no contest) was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor). The Commission suspended \$500 of the fine provided the licensee not receive a similar violation within one year.

During the public hearings portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Macuore, Inc.** for the transfer of the business and Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and dancing) of **Shigezo Hawaii, Inc.** (dba **808 Kapahulu**) at 808 Kapahulu Ave. and for a change of trade name to **Modern Kappo Miyabi**.
- Approved the application from **Office Gaia, LLC** (dba **Live 99**) for a Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 3 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing). Per Rule 3-82-38.25, the Commission placed the restriction of no dancing on the license.

During the preliminary hearings, license applications and requests portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the applications from **Waiialae Country Club** for Special General licenses from Jan. 10 to 18, 2009 at 4997 Kahala Ave.
- Approved the applications from **Festival Events Hawaii LLC** for Special Beer licenses from Jan. 10 to 18, 2009 at 4997 Kahala Ave.
- Approved the application from **JXT Incorporated** for the transfer of the business and Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 4 – Hostess) of **LTI, Inc.** (dba **Club Romantei**) at 1400 Kapiolani Blvd. and for a change of trade name to **All Star Lounge**. The Commission also approved a Temporary Dispenser General license.
- Continued the application from **Seven-Eleven (Hawaii), Inc.** (dba **7-Eleven Stores**) for a Retail General license at 99-236 Moanalua Rd. to mid-January 2009.
- Approved the application from **Meridian Sports Centers Hawaii, LLC** (dba **Honolulu Club**) for renewal of its Temporary Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 1 – Standard Bar).
- Approved the applications from **RY-9, Inc.** (dba **Roy's Ko Olina**) for Caterer licenses to cater off the licensed premises to 92-106 Waialii Pl. on Dec. 5 and 19, 2008 and Jan. 2 and 16 and Feb. 6 and 20, 2009.
- Approved the request from **Di's Karaoke, LLC** for the transfer of membership interest and notification of admission of member.
- Approved the request from **Longs Drug Stores California, Inc.** (dba **Longs Drug Stores**) (for all 22 locations) for notification of conversion of the corporation to **Longs Drug Stores California, L.L.C., a limited liability company**, and notification of new member.
- Approved the request from **F.L. Inc.** (dba **Don Ho's Island Grill**) to temporarily extend its licensed premises from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Dec. 13, 2008.

- Approved the request from **Slow Down Town LLC** (dba **Downtown**) to temporarily extend its licensed premises from 5 p.m. to 9 p.m. on Dec. 5, 2008; Jan. 2 and 16, 2009; Feb. 6, 2009; March 6, 2009; April 3, 2009; May 1, 2009; and June 5, 2009.
- Approved the request from **1128 Building, LLC** (dba **L G W**) to change event date on Special License Appl. No. 1445 from March 6, 2009 to Jan. 2, 2009.
- Denied the request from **James Yi** (dba **Pali Bottle Shoppe**) for reconsideration of Commission Order dated Nov. 6, 2008, assessing a penalty of \$350 for violation of Rule 3-82-38.9(a).

During the other business portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Reviewed the three-month probationary period for **Mexico Lindo Restaurant, Ltd.** (dba **Mexico Lindo**) and ended the probation.
