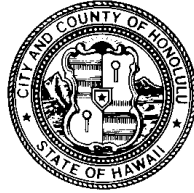

Honolulu Liquor Commission fines Phuket Thai Restaurant, Amy's Place, ABC Store No. 81, Moulin Rouge Night Club, Le Bistro, Alapai Café, Bar & Grill Lanikai, Hyung Je Joomooluck and Cheeseburger Waikiki Limited Partnership for selling, serving or furnishing liquor to minors

- Tondo-Tondo, Inc. also denied motion for reconsideration regarding license revocation -

HONOLULU (Dec. 12, 2008) – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 21st meeting of the fiscal year on Dec. 11, 2008.

- **Phuket Thai Restaurant** (default), **Amy's Place** (no contest) and **ABC Store No. 81** (no contest) each were fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor).
- **Moulin Rouge Night Club** admitted to the allegations and was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor).
- **Le Bistro** (no contest) and **Alapai Cafe** (no contest) each were fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor). The Commission suspended \$250 of the fine provided the licensee receives no similar violations within one year.
- **Bar & Grill Lanikai** (no contest) was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor). The Commission suspended \$500 of the fine provided the licensee receives no similar violations within one year.
- **Hyung Je Joomooluck** (no contest) was fined \$2,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor). The Commission will give the licensee credit towards the fine for purchasing an ID scanner and surge protector. The licensee will then be required to pay the balance.
- **Cheeseburger Waikiki Limited Partnership** (no contest) was fined \$2,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor). The Commission suspended \$500 of the fine provided the licensee receives no similar violations within one year.

During the public hearings portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Vivirang, LLC** for the transfer of the business and Retail General license of **Smart Trades, LLC** (dba **1 2 3 Store**) at 430 Lewers St., #100.
- Approved the application from **Jungle Juice Market LLC** for a Retail General license at 95-020 Waihau St.
- Approved the application from **CB Beachwalk Inc.** for a Restaurant General license (Cat. No. 2 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 226 Lewers St., Space No. L-200.

During the preliminary hearing, license application and request portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Found a substantial change in the circumstances that caused the previous license denial and approved the application from **Gara, Inc.** (dba **Hawaiian Brian's Billiards**) for a Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 3 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 1687 Kalauokalani Way.
- Approved the application from **Parker, Inc.** (dba **Round Table Pizza**) for approval of the transfer of capital stock and notification of new officers, director and stockholders at 1020-J Keolu Dr.
- Denied the request from **William A. Harrison, Esq.**, on behalf of **Tondo-Tondo, Inc.** to withdraw its previous no contest plea. The Commission also denied reconsideration and denied a stay of the decision and order regarding the revocation of a Cabaret General license on Oct. 9, 2008.

During the other business portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the ratification of the Administrative Actions Report for November 2008.
- Heard a weekly report on administrative matters from the Liquor Administrator.
