Ku’Ai Market-02, Don Ho’s Island Grill, Ilikai General Store, Uptown Café , King’s Pub, Panda Cuisine, Toho Japanese Restaurant-Café, Seoul Market, Phuket Thai Restaurant, California Pizza Kitchen, Chili’s Grill and Bar, Foodland Super Market, Ltd. Store No. 2, Foodland Super Market, Ltd. Store No. 8, Kam Heong Market, Ltd., Seoul Market receive fines for selling, serving or furnishing liquor to minors

HONOLULU (Jan. 20, 2009) – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 25th meeting of the fiscal year on Jan. 15, 2009.

- **Arnold’s Beach Bar & Grill** (no contest) received a letter of reprimand for violation of Section 281-91, HRS (failing to comply with Commission Order of June 5, 2008 requiring all its servers attend and pass server training within 90 days from the date of service of said Order).
- **Ku’Ai Market-02** (no contest) was fined \$2,000 for a repeat violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor).
- **Don Ho’s Island Grill** was fined a total of \$2,000 for two violations of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor). The Commission will allow \$1,000 of the fine to be used towards purchasing an ID checking machine within 30 days (licensee must provide receipt).
- **Ilikai General Store** (no contest) was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor). The Commission will allow \$500 of the fine to be used towards purchasing an ID checking machine within 30 days (licensee must provide receipt).
- **Uptown Café** (no contest), **King’s Pub** (no contest), **Panda Cuisine** (no contest), **Toho Japanese Restaurant-Cafe** (no contest) and **Seoul Market** (no contest) each were fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor).

- **Phuket Thai Restaurant** (no contest), **California Pizza Kitchen** (no contest), **Chili's Grill and Bar** (no contest), **Foodland Super Market, Ltd. Store No. 2** (no contest), **Foodland Super Market, Ltd. Store No. 8** (no contest) and **Kam Heong Market, Ltd.** (no contest) each were fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor). The Commission suspended \$250 of each fine provided the licensee receives no similar violation within one year.

During the public hearing portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Fresh Catch LLC** (dba **Fresh Catch LLC**) for a Retail General license 3109 Waialae Ave.)

During the preliminary hearings, license applications and requests portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **SJY Inc.** for the transfer of the business and Retail General license of **Auger Enterprises Incorporated** (dba **Iolani Mini-Mart**) at 2499 Kapiolani Blvd., and for a change of trade name to **Iolani Mini Mart**. The Commission also approved a Temporary Retail General license.
- Approved the application from **Food Pantry, Ltd.** (dba **Accents**) for a Retail General license at 2259 Kalakaua Ave. (**Royal Hawaiian Hotel**). The Commission approved a related request from **Kyo-ya Hotels & Resorts, LP** (dba **Royal Hawaiian Hotel**) to permanently delete the area from its licensed premises.
- Approved the application from **Target Corporation** (dba **Target Store T-2410**) for a Retail General license at 4380 Lawehana St.
- Approved the application from **Target Corporation** (dba **Target Store T-2411**) for a Retail General license at 4450 Kapolei Parkway, Suite 100.
- Approved the application from **J Food & Beverage, LLC** (dba **The Restaurant at the Alana / JBistro Martini & Wine / J Restaurant**) for a Temporary Hotel General license at 1956 Ala Moana Blvd. (the current site of the **Doubletree Alana Waikiki**).

During the other business portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Heard a weekly report on administrative matters from the Liquor Administrator.
- Met in executive session to discuss personnel and employment matters.
