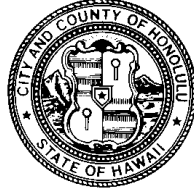

**Commission hears Notice of Petition and Hearing for non-renewal of Mall Café's  
liquor license and continues the petition and five adjudications to April 30  
- Commission also fined Democrat Market \$2,000 for a repeat violation of  
selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor -**

**HONOLULU (April 17, 2009)** – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 37<sup>th</sup> meeting of the fiscal year on April 16, 2009.

- **Democrat Market** (no contest) was fined \$2,000 for a repeat violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor).
- **Mall Café** denied the allegations and the Commission continued the adjudications against the licensee until April 30, 2009 for two violations of Rule 3-84-72.1 (licensee failed to keep its premises in a clean and sanitary condition, to wit, bottles of liquor contained small dead insects), one violation of Rule 3-84-78.52 (stacking), one violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(B), HRS (licensee sold, served, furnished or allowed the consumption of liquor by a person who was at the time under the influence of liquor), and violation of Rule 3-82-38.4(b)(time card). The Commission also continued until April 30, 2009, the Notice of Petition and Hearing for nonrenewal of Dispenser General License No. E1407 issued to Saiming Corporation (dba Mall Café) at 80 South Pauahi St.

During the preliminary hearings, license and request portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Sun Ann Hong, LLC** for the transfer of the business and Cabaret General license of **Komoko, LLC** (dba **Fashion 45**) at 2255 Kuhio Ave., Suite M-1.
- Approved the application from **Ha Yun Corporation** for the transfer of the business and Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 3 and 4 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing; and Hostess) of **Ken & Ken International, Inc.** (dba **Cheers Karaoke, Bar & Grill**) at 434 Piikoi St. and for a change of trade name to **CEO Lounge**. The Commission also approved a Temporary Dispenser General license.

- Approved the application from **M & S Store, Inc.** for the transfer of the business and Retail General license of JYS Incorporated (dba **Bobo's Mini Mart**) at 98-064 Kamehameha Hwy. The Commission also approved a Temporary Retail General license.
- Continued until May 28, 2009 the application from **Nashnal Hospitality Inc.** (dba **Margaritas Local Beach Bar**) for a change of class from a Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 3 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) to a Cabaret General license at 1778 Ala Moana Blvd., Suite LL12.
- Approved the application from **SSK Corporation** (dba **Tanabe Market**) for a Temporary Retail General license at 934 Keeaumoku St., the current site of **M.S. Tanabe Superette**. The Commission also approved a related request from **Tanabe Superette Inc.** (dba **M.S. Tanabe Superette**) to permanently extend and alter the interior of its licensed premises.
- Approved the application from **Koike, Inc.** (dba **Anna Lounge**) for the transfer of capital stock and notification of new officer, director and stockholder at 180 N. Nimitz Hwy.

During the other business portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved a request from **Food Pantry, Ltd.** (dba **Accents**) at 1811 Ala Moana Blvd. to waive requirements to submit a Personal History and Affidavit, Request for Criminal History Record Clearance of its officers, directors, and majority stockholders of the corporation; and Articles of Incorporation. The Commission did request the licensee to update the personal history of principals, certify that none are convicted felons and to provide a copy of the current Articles of Incorporation.
- Ratified the Administrative Actions Report for March 2009.
- Heard a weekly report on administrative matters from the Liquor Administrator.
- Met in Executive Session to consult with **Linda Kreis** regarding investigation findings, in accordance with HRS 92-5(a)(2).
