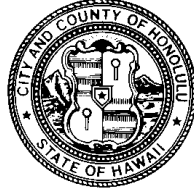

**Commission fines The Shack Waikiki, LLC for failing to suppress
an altercation between a patron and an employee**

HONOLULU (April 24, 2009) – The Honolulu Liquor Commission (HLC) took the following action at its 38th meeting of the fiscal year on April 23, 2009.

- **Silk Lady Lounge** pled not guilty for three violations of Rule 3-84-78.042 (fondling), one violation of Rule 3-84-78.01 (licensee's employee consumption of liquor while on duty on the licensed premises), three violations of Rule 3-84-78.01(c) (licensee's employee solicited or accepted food or beverage as a gift from or at the expense of a customer while on duty on the licensed premises) and one violation of Rule 3-82-38.4(b) (time card); the adjudications were continued to May 14, 2009. In addition, the licensee pled no contest to two violations of Rule 3-84-78.01 (licensee's employee consumption of liquor while on duty on the licensed premises) and four violations of Rule 3-82-38.4(b) (time card) and the penalty phase of these adjudications also was continued until May 14, 2009.
- **The Shack Waikiki, LLC** (no contest) was fined \$1,000 for violation of Section 281-78(b)(6), HRS (failing to immediately prevent and/or suppress violent, quarrelsome, disorderly, lewd immoral or unlawful conduct of any person on the licensed premises, to wit, a confrontation and/or altercation between a patron and Licensee's employee(s)).
- The adjudication against **C & G Mini Mart** for violation of Section 281-78(b)(1)(A), HRS (selling, serving or furnishing liquor to a minor) was continued to April 30, 2009.

During the public hearings portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Koa Bar LLC** for a Dispenser General license (Cat. No. 3 – Live entertainment or Recorded Music and Dancing) at 2410 Koa Ave., Unit No. 5.
- Approved the application from **Kuo & Sun, LLC** (dba **The Mandarin Restaurant**) for a Restaurant Beer and Wine license (Cat. No. 1 – Standard Bar) at 725 Kapiolani Blvd., #C-123 (**The Imperial Plaza**).

During the license and requests portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved the application from **Next Door Partners LLC** for a Special General license on May 1, 5 and 15, 2009. In addition, the Commission requested HLC enforcement to monitor the events and if there is a violation on the first event, the approvals for the subsequent events will be revoked.
- Approved the application from **Ichiriki, Inc.** (dba **Izakaya Nonbei**) for approval of the transfer of capital stock and notification of new officer, director and stockholder.
- Approved the request from **Sergio's Diamond Head, LLC** (dba **Sergio's Italian Restaurant**) for the transfer of membership interest and notification of admission of member at 449 Kapahulu Ave. The Commission also approved a similar request from **Sergio's, LLC** (dba **Sergio's Italian Table**) for the transfer of membership interest and notification of admission of member at 2005 Kalia Road.
- Approved the request from **Hilton Hawaiian Village LLC** to permanently extend, alter and redefine its licensed premises to include the **Grand Waikikian** building and the **Paradise Pool** at 2005 Kalia Road.
- Approved the request from **Ken & Ken International, Inc.** (dba **Cheers Karaoke, Bar & Grill**) to permanently alter its licensed premises at 434 Piikoi St.
- Approved the request from **Marriott Hotel Services, Inc.** (dba **Marriott's Ko Olina Beach Club**) to temporarily delete from its licensed premises the Great Lawn from 11:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. on May 22, 2009.
- Approved the request from **RY-9, Inc.** (dba **Roy's Ko Olina**) to temporarily delete from its licensed premises the upper level private banquet room from 5:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. on May 21, 2009.
- Approved the request from **Tri-Star Restaurant Group II, LLC** (dba **Aaron's Atop the Ala Moana**) to transfer its liquor inventory to **Sarento's Top of the I.**

During the other business portion of the meeting, the Commission:

- Approved a request from **HFWP, LLC** (dba **Hawaii Food & Wine Paradise**) to waive requirements to submit a Personal History and Affidavit, Request for Criminal History Record Clearance for **Dane Keola Lloyd**. The Commission did request the licensee to update the personal history, certify that he is not a convicted felon and to submit a new fingerprint card.
- Heard a weekly report on administrative matters from the Liquor Administrator.
- Met in Executive Session to confer with counsel regarding personnel and employment matters, in accordance with HRS 92-5(a)(2).
