§03-07-1 Purpose. The purpose of this section is to set the City's service fee for a dishonored check. [Eff 10/31/2004] (Auth: ROH §2-4.2(b); RCH §4-105) (Imp: ROH §2-4.2(b))

§03-71-2 Definitions. (a) "Director" refers to the Director of the Department of Budget and Fiscal Services of the City and County of Honolulu.

(b) "Dishonored Check" refers to a check issued to the City as payment for taxes, assessments, service fees, rentals, recovery of expenditures, etc., which is subsequently rejected for payment by a bank or other financial institution when presented for collection. A check may be dishonored for such reasons as insufficient funds, a closed account, or an improper signature. Excluded from this definition is a check in which payment has been stopped because of a duplicate payment. [Eff 10/31/2004] (Auth: ROH §2-4.2(b)) (Imp: ROH §2-4.2(b))


§03-71-3 Dishonored Check Service Fee. A service fee shall be the amount specified in HRS 40-35.5. [Eff 10/31/2004; am JAN 15 2010]

§03-71-4 Severability. If any provision of this rule, or the application to any person or circumstances, is held invalid, the remainder of the rule, or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances, shall not be affected. [Eff 10/31/2004] (Auth: RCH §4-105) (Imp: ROH §2-4.2(b))



These rules shall take effect ten days after filing with the Office of the City Clerk.




