The below bills will crossover on March 12<sup>th</sup> for further committee hearings. Copies of the proposed measures can be obtained by clicking on the bill number hyperlink.

<b>Bill Number</b>	<b>Description</b>
<a href="#"><u>HB293</u></a> <a href="#"><u>HD1</u></a>	Allows those applying for liquor licenses to present a certificate of vendor compliance issued by Hawaii compliance express to establish they do not owe delinquent taxes, penalties, or interest.
<a href="#"><u>HB770</u></a> <a href="#"><u>HD1</u></a>	Authorizes restaurants and retail dealers with a liquor license to sell beer, malt beverages, or cider for off-premises consumption, under certain conditions. Authorizes brewpubs and small craft producer pubs with a liquor license to sell for off-premises consumption malt beverages purchased from another liquor licensee.
<a href="#"><u>SB868</u></a> <a href="#"><u>SD1</u></a>	Requires county liquor commissions that choose to regulate dancing to adopt or amend rules regarding limitations on dancing.
<a href="#"><u>SB1151</u></a> <a href="#"><u>SD2</u></a>	Authorizes restaurants with a liquor license to sell beer, malt beverages, or cider for off-premises consumption, under certain conditions. Authorizes retail dealers with a class 4 liquor license to sell beer, malt beverages, or cider in non-original packages, under certain conditions. Authorizes brewpubs and small craft producer pubs with a liquor license to sell malt beverages purchased from another liquor licensee for off-premises consumption. Effective July 1, 2020.
<a href="#"><u>SB1154</u></a>	For counties with a population of five hundred thousand or more: requires a public hearing before the liquor commission on an application for a liquor license to be held not less than thirty days after the first public notice for the hearing.
<a href="#"><u>SB1368</u></a> <a href="#"><u>SD2</u></a>	Prohibits the sale of liquor at street closure events except under certain conditions. Effective July 1, 2020.
