Bills not passed this session will carry over and still be alive at the beginning of the 2016 legislative session, where they will continue from where they stalled in the 2015 session. <b>Bill Number</b>	<b>Description</b>	<b>Date Enrolled to/Action by Governor</b>
<a href="#">Act 227</a>	Authorizes restaurants with a liquor license to sell beer, malt beverages, or cider for off-premises consumption, under certain conditions. Authorizes retail dealers with a liquor license to sell beer, malt beverages, or cider in non-original packages, under certain conditions. Authorizes brewpubs and small craft producer pubs with a liquor license to sell malt beverages manufactured on the premises or purchased from another liquor licensee for off-premises consumption. (SD1)	Effective upon 7/13/15 approval
<a href="#">Act 186</a>	Prohibits the consumption, purchase, possession, and sale and distribution of powdered alcohol. Defines powdered alcohol. (HD2)	Effective upon 7/1/15 approval
<a href="#">Act 136</a>	Authorizes county liquor commissions to prescribe regulations on dancing in establishments licensed to serve alcohol. Requires liquor commissions that do regulate dancing to adopt or amend administrative rules, no later than October 1, 2015, regarding dancing in premises licensed to sell liquor for consumption thereon and include a definition of "dancing" in those rules. (CD1)	Effective upon 6/19/15 approval
