NOTICE TO ALL PROSPECTIVE OFFERORS:

This Addendum is hereby made a part of the Request for Qualifications for the HONOLULU RAIL TRANSIT PROJECT (H RTP), WEST SECTION CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING AND INSPECTION PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT, and it shall amend the said Request for Qualifications in the following respects:

**ITEM NO. 3 – QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES**

The following questions were received in the Transit Mailbox and at the Pre-Submittal Conference; the responses from the Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation (HART) are as follows:

Question #1

Will the two Guideway and Utilities DB contracts held by KIWC be administered as two separate contracts or is there a possibility they could be administered as one contract?

**Response #1**

**Kiewit was awarded the West Oahu/Farrington Highway Guideway design-build contract and the Kamehameha Highway Guideway design-build contract. The contracts are separate and are administered separately. There is no plan to change this arrangement.**

**Question #2**

Can you please provide more information on the Maintenance and Storage Facility project including the KKJV contract (did not find the KKJV contract in the HART Library of HART contracts)?

**Response #2**

**The MSF contract documents are being uploaded to the Honolulutransit.org library. The Maintenance and Storage Facility (MSF) is a design-build contract that was awarded to Kiewit / Kobayashi, a Joint Venture. The rail project requires a MSF to service, inspect, and store the fleet of vehicles that the system will operate. The site is located off Farrington Highway between Waipahu High School and Leeward Community College. The MSF consist of several buildings along with storage tracks and other yard tracks for servicing the vehicles.**

**Question #3**

There is no listing or mention of CE&I Organization and Duties in the Contract Resident Engineer (CRE) Manual for Design-Build (DB) and Design-Build-Operate-Maintain (DBOM) Contracts; can you please provide clarification of CE&I Organization and Duties for DB Contracts?

**Response #3**

**CE&I services are presently part of the General Engineering Contract II scope of services; however, the firm selected for the Construction Engineering & Inspection (CE&I) West Contract will be responsible for CE&I for the design-build contracts located within the geographical boundary for this CE&I contract. Presently all DB contracts are located within the boundary of the CE&I West Contract. The CRE Manuals are currently being revised to further reflect the duties for CE&I contracts. A separate solicitation will be issued for the CE&I and design oversight services for the DBOM contract.**

**Question #4**

Will the CE&I have any design review responsibilities for the DB contracts?

**Response #4**

**While the CE&I contractor will have to interface with the DB designers, design reviews will be provided under a separate contract.**

Question #5

As the Pre-Submittal Conference was rescheduled and in order to fully incorporate HART information provided and responses to questions into our Submittal Materials packet we respectfully request an extension of the submittal due date by a minimum of one week.

Response #5

**We are unable to accommodate this request at this time.**

Question #6

Can you clarify whether HART will be self performing the project-wide construction safety and security programming and oversight or will HART be procuring these services through a separate solicitation?

Response #6

**HART expects to either self-perform or issue a separate solicitation for safety, security and oversight services; however, the CE&I scope will include activities to confirm that construction contractors are complying with the requirements of the construction contract in these and all other areas.**

Question #7

Should HART procure these services separately from the GEC or CE&I procurements, are we correct in assuming the consultant selected to provide the project-wide safety services would have an organizational conflict of interest should they also provide services under the CE&I contract(s) related to monitoring contractor's adherence to Site Safety and Security requirements?

Response #7

**Yes -- the CE&I contractor would not be eligible to be awarded a contract covering safety, security, and oversight services should HART decide to issue a separate solicitation for this work.**

Question #8

Our firm is currently performing final design work as a prime consultant on a station group. Does HART see any conflicts in our participation as a prime or a subcontractor for this solicitation?

Response #8

**Due to conflict of interest concerns, the prime consultants holding station group design contracts are precluded from participating as the prime consultant for the Section (West or East) in which the station group resides. The prime consultants holding station group design contracts are also precluded from participating as a subconsultant performing work on the station group for which they performed work.**

**For other questions, refer to page 5 of the Request for Qualifications and consult the section entitled, "Organizational Conflict of Interest and Non-Disclosure Requirement," for guidance. Please refer your specific question to your firm's legal advisor for determination.**

**Question #9**

We are a State of Hawaii certified Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) and given that the Pre-Submittal Conference just occurred, we respectfully request a minimum of one (1) week extension of the due date to allow for DBEs to participate in this solicitation.

**Response #9**

**At this time we are not able to extend the deadline for submission responses as requested. Please note that the RFQ included an indicative list of tasks of the work that will be required. The full scope of services will be developed during negotiations with the top ranked firms. Accordingly, the precise work to be done and the schedule of performance have not been fully defined. As described in the RFQ the evaluation and ranking process will consider the prime consultant and its designated major-subconsultants. HART will not preclude the firm who is awarded the contract from proposing to add qualified subconsultants to its team even though they were not named in the initial response to the RFQ.**

**Question #10**

[Consultant], a DBE, MBE and SBE firm who wishes to team with a prime, respectively requests an extension of the deadline for this procurement because most of the primes did not attend the pre-proposal meeting. Additionally, we kindly request a list of firms who have expressed interest.

**Response #10**

- There will be a requirement to report DBE participation/accomplishments with each invoice.



7. Award, HART returns signed contract and issues NTP
8. Award is posted and notice sent to non-selected firms

# RFQ Requirements (Continued)

  - ✓ Registrations / certifications / licenses
  - ✓ References ( 3 max)
  - ✓ Work experience on “relevant projects” (up to 5)
  - ✓ Current Employer

# RFQ Requirements (Continued)

- Major Subconsultants – Teaming
  - ✓ Legal relationship (subcontract / teaming agreement)
  - ✓ Qualifications, capability, past performance evaluated along with Prime
- List of all Subconsultants

# RFQ Requirements (Continued)

- Organization chart
  - ✓ Key Individuals
  - ✓ Geographic location identified
  - ✓ Prime, Subconsultant identified
  - ✓ Interfaces (Prime/Sub & disciplines)

# RFQ Requirements (Continued)

- Financial capacity – Current Balance Sheet – “Certified True Copy”
- Any unique approach to accomplish the work
  - Identify Risk and Challenges – Top 5
  - Risk Monitoring and Management
  - Claims management and Avoidance
- Confidentiality/Proprietary Marking

# Evaluation Process

- Purpose: select Offerors that are *“Responsive” to the RFQ requirements*
  - *“Responsive” – Completeness* of the submittal responses to the requirements
- Evaluation of proposals will be conducted in accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rules §3-122-52 and §3-122-53

# Evaluation Process

## Selection Criteria\*

- Experience and professional qualifications relevant to the Contract;
- Past performance on projects of similar scope for public agencies or private industry, including corrective actions and other responses to notices of deficiencies;
  - Recent – w/in past 10 years
  - Relevant – (scope, magnitude, breadth of capability, etc.)
- Capacity to accomplish the work in the required time
- Project Approach

\* Descending order of importance

# Evaluation Process – Discussions, Scoring & Ranking

- Discussions (if required)
  - Confidential discussions regarding the services which are required and the services they are able to provide
  - No disclosure of any information derived from the competing professional service Offerors.
- Scoring & Ranking
  - Proposals are scored based on evaluation criteria
  - A minimum of three firms based on the selection criteria
  - Ranking sent to the HART Chief Procurement Officer (CPO)

# Negotiations

- The CPO or designee shall negotiate a contract with the 1<sup>st</sup> ranked firm
- Including fair and reasonable compensation based upon the
  - Scope
  - Schedule
  - Fee within Budget
- If Fee negotiations are not successful with 1<sup>st</sup> ranked, we will cease negotiations and go to 2<sup>nd</sup> ranked firm

# RFQ Requirements (Continued)

## **ORGANIZATIONAL CONFLICT OF INTEREST**

- 1) Participation by Persons (and/or Affiliates) on more than one Offeror's team performing more than fifteen percent (15%) of the Work;
- 2) A Person (and/or Affiliate) who produced design plans or deliverables, under an existing HART Contract, which could be the subject of review, approval and/or management by the same Person (the awarded offeror) under this Contract;
- 4) A Person (at any tier) who is paid for developing or preparing specifications or work statements in the development of this solicitation package or the resulting contract is precluded from submitting an offer or receiving a contract for this solicitation in accordance with HRS § 103D-405(d) and HAR § 3-122-13(e); or
- 5) A Person who is currently providing services under an existing contract which may place that Person, if awarded the contract under this solicitation, to represent divergent interests in the course of this Contract.

- We do not expect to withhold retention


