2019 National Association of Counties (NACo) Annual Conference and Exposition Travel Report

The National Association of Counties (NACo) Annual Conference and Exposition was held in Clark County Nevada in July of this year. I attended in my official capacity as the President of the Hawaii State Association of Counties (HSAC), who leads the voting delegates of Kauai, Oahu, Maui, and Hawaii Counties in the NACo's annual business meeting and election of officers. I am also a member of NACo's Large Urban Caucus—a policy making body that serves as the counties' voice before the U.S. Congress and the Administration. Additionally, I attended the Transportation and Infrastructure Track of this year's conference.

Large Urban County Caucus (LUCC)

America's urban counties play a prominent role in 150 million residents' lives every day. We foster conditions for economic strength, build and maintain transportation systems and critical infrastructure, promote community health and well-being, champion justice and public safety and implement a broad portfolio of federal, state and local programs.

The National Association of Counties (NACo) Large Urban County Caucus, or "LUCC," is the premier forum for urban county leaders and is the voice for America's metropolitan counties before Congress and the Administration. Comprised of county executives, governing board members and other senior elected officials, LUCC members focus on urban challenges and solutions, engage in peer-to-peer information exchanges, and inform national policy discussions.

Transportation and Infrastructure Track

Infrastructure provides the backbone for county operations. Counties invest more than \$122 billion annually in building infrastructure and maintaining and operating public works. Counties build and maintain 46 percent of public roads and 38 percent of bridges, are involved in 34 percent of airports across the U.S., support 960 hospitals throughout the U.S., and spend almost \$26 billion on correctional facilities annually and \$21.6 billion on sewage and waste management. The decisions that county leaders make every day about transportation, infrastructure, land use and economic development policies and investments influence local and national economic opportunities, shape how communities grow and change and contribute to Americans' quality of life.

The Transportation Steering Committee is responsible for all matters pertaining to federal transportation legislation, funding and regulation and its impacts on county government. This includes highway and bridge development, finance and safety, public transit development and finance, transportation planning, airport development and service, passenger and freight railroads, ports and waterways, freight movement, and research and development of new modes of transportation.

NACo supports efforts by the administration and Congress to increase our nation's infrastructure investments to help promote economic development, public safety and overall mobility. Any federal infrastructure package should reflect county priorities, such as: allocating more federal seed capital and matching funds for locally owned infrastructure, increasing local decision-making authority and flexibility, and stream-lining and shortening the federal permitting process while still requiring robust public participation and world-class environmental stewardship.


