However, beginning Sunday, August 20, the numbering for both Honolulu-bound and Kailua bound buses using Pali Hwy will change from Route 85 to Route 87. The numbering for Honolulu bound and Kaneohe bound buses using Likelike will stay Route 85. TheBus staff will be distributing brochures to riders in late July/early August regarding these changes.

Kailua Beach Park Pavilion & Bathrooms

I am happy to announce that the Kailua Beach Park bathhouse and pavilion, re-opened on Monday, July 3 following an extensive renovation that began back in November 2016. Various repairs were conducted that included roof repair, landscaping, pathway repair, new plumbing fixtures, interior and exterior wall renovations as well as the addition of security measures. The contract for the renovations was awarded to Maxum Construction of Hawaii at a cost of \$952,727. This was a significant project for the Kailua Community as Kailua Beach Park is an important and beautiful beach for use by residents and visitors alike.

Executive Operating and Capital Improvement Budgets

Mayor Caldwell recently returned unsigned, the Legislative Budget (Bill 24, CD2), the Executive Operating Budget (Bill 25, CD2, FD1), the Executive Capital Budget (Bill 26, CD2, FD1), for fiscal year July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018. Those bills will become law without the Mayor's signature.

The budget committee, of which I was a member, looked at many proposals and options to come up with a balanced budget as required by law. This budget places a priority on core basic city services and infrastructure such as our roads, sewers and public safety along with other needs of the city without raising property taxes. As for the capital improvement budget, I was able to obtain funding for a dog park in the Windward side, additional funding for roads and sewers in our Council District, mangrove removal and other monies for park improvements throughout our district.
