VOTER INFORMATION

Who Can Register To Vote

- **A citizen of the United States**

Non-U.S. citizens including U.S. Nationals do not qualify

- **At least 16 years of age** (must be 18 to vote)

- **A resident of the State of Hawaii**

Residence is not simply because of presence in this state, but is acquired with the intent to make Hawaii the legal residence with all the accompanying obligations therein.

When you register to vote and are properly registered, you will automatically receive a ballot in the mail. No traditional Election Day polling places will be established!

To check your registration status, visit www.olvr.hawaii.gov with a valid Hawaii Driver's License/Hawaii State ID, or call our office.

Absentee Voting

If you will be away and need a ballot sent to a temporary address, fill out the red Absentee Application form.

Voter registration deadlines

Voter registration applications must be postmarked or received by the Clerk's office by the thirtieth day prior to the primary, general, or special election.

Voter Registration Cancellation

Visit our website or call our office for assistance.

Voting Instructions

Read the ballot and envelope instructions carefully.

Sign the affirmation statement on your return envelope! Your ballot WILL NOT be counted if it is not signed.

Have a plan to return your ballot.

Ballots received **after 7:00 PM** on Election Day will NOT be counted. Postmarks DO NOT apply.

Return your ballot:

- At any place of deposit location
- At a Voter Service Center
- By mail - No postage is required!
Consider estimated USPS delivery times when returning your ballot in the final days leading up to Election Day.
- For locations and available dates of your nearest ballot drop box or Voter Service Center, visit our website or call our office.

Replacement Ballot
