

TRAILER REGISTRATION

Registering New Trailers bought from Oahu Dealer

- Submit completed CS-L (MVR) 14 form (Application For Registration of Trailer). Ensure the reverse side of the form is countersigned by the selling dealer.
- Submit Hawaii Vehicle Inspection Certificate if the trailer weight is 10,000 lbs or less. Note: If the GVW (gross vehicle weight) of the trailer is more than 10,000 lbs, a State Department of Transportation Inspection Certificate must be submitted. For more information, contact: Department of Transportation, Motor Vehicle Safety Office: 692-7661.
- Required fees will be determined by Motor Vehicle or Satellite City Hall staff.

Registering New Trailers bought from an Out-of-County Dealer

- Submit completed CS-L (MVR) 14 form (Application For Registration of Trailer).
- Submit Manufacturers Certificate of Origin (MCO) for the Trailer. The assignment section on the reverse side of the MCO must be endorsed to you. A copy will be kept and the original MCO will be returned to you.
- Submit Hawaii Vehicle Inspection Certificate if the trailer weight is 10,000 lbs or less. Note: If the GVW (gross vehicle weight) of the trailer is more than 10,000 lbs, a State Department of Transportation Inspection Certificate must be submitted. For more information, contact: Department of Transportation, Motor Vehicle Safety Office: 692-7661.
- Required fees will be determined by Motor Vehicle or Satellite City Hall staff.

Registering Homemade or Shop Built Trailers

- Submit completed CS-L (MVR) 14 form (Application For Registration of Trailer).
- Submit weight slip from a certified State weighmaster.
- Submit Hawaii Vehicle Inspection Certificate if the trailer weight is 10,000 lbs or less. Note: If the GVW (gross vehicle weight) of the trailer is more than 10,000 lbs, a State Department of Transportation Inspection Certificate must be submitted. For more information, contact: Department of Transportation, Motor Vehicle Safety Office: 692-7661.
- Required fees will be determined by Motor Vehicle or Satellite City Hall staff.
- A VIN (Vehicle Identification Number) will be assigned to the trailer upon completion of registration.

Registering trailers previously registered out-of-state in the applicant's name

- Submit completed CS-L (MVR) 14 form (Application For Registration of Trailer).
- Submit the other jurisdiction's last issued certificate of registration/title for the trailer.
- Submit Hawaii Vehicle Inspection Certificate if the trailer weight is 10,000 lbs or less. Note: If the GVW (gross vehicle weight) of the trailer is more than 10,000 lbs, a State Department of Transportation Inspection Certificate must be submitted. For more information, contact: Department of Transportation, Motor Vehicle Safety Office: 692-7661.
- Submit weight slip from a certified State weighmaster.
- Submit Bill of Lading indicating the date of arrival of the trailer in Hawaii.
- Trailer Vehicle Identification Number must be inspected by the Motor Vehicle Control Section. Inspections conducted by appointment only. Call 733-2542.
- Required fees will be determined by Motor Vehicle or Satellite City Hall staff.

Registering trailers previously registered out-of-state NOT in the applicant's name

- Submit completed CS-L (MVR) 14 form (Application For Registration of Trailer).
- Submit the other jurisdiction's last issued certificate of registration/title for the trailer. If the certificate of title does not indicate a transfer of ownership from the recorded owner to the applicant, a bill of sale must be presented.
- Submit Hawaii Vehicle Inspection Certificate if the trailer weight is 10,000 lbs or less. Note: If the GVW (gross vehicle weight) of the trailer is more than 10,000 lbs, a State Department of Transportation Inspection Certificate must be submitted. For more information, contact: Department of Transportation, Motor Vehicle Safety Office: 692-7661.
- Submit weight slip from a certified State weighmaster.
- Submit Bill of Lading indicating the date of arrival of the trailer in Hawaii.
- Trailer Vehicle Identification Number must be inspected by the Motor Vehicle Control Section. Inspections conducted by appointment only. Call 733-2542.
- Required fees will be determined by Motor Vehicle or Satellite City Hall staff.

Transfer of Honolulu registered trailer

- Submit the properly endorsed last issued Certificate of Trailer Registration.
- Submit Hawaii Vehicle Inspection Certificate.
- Required fees will be determined by Motor Vehicle or Satellite City Hall staff.
