**PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE
To Adopt Proposed City and County of Honolulu
Administrative Rules, Title 12, Chapter 3,
Honolulu Zoo**

Notice is hereby given of proposed rulemaking and public hearing by the Department of Enterprise Services, City and County of Honolulu, for the adoption of proposed City and County of Honolulu Administrative Rules, Title 12 Chapter 3, governing the Honolulu Zoo ("proposed rules").

The Department of Enterprise Services proposes to adopt new rules establishing non-resident admission fees for admission to the Honolulu Zoo.

The proposed new rules are summarized as follows:

- §12-3-1. Purpose. The purpose of this chapter is to establish the non-resident fees for admission to the Honolulu Zoo.
- §12-3-2: Definitions. Adds definition of "Resident of Hawaii" and "Non-resident of Hawaii".
- §12-3-3: Admission fees. Establishes non-resident admission fees for entry to the Honolulu Zoo.

A public hearing will be held on Tuesday, October 24, 2017 in the Hawaii Suites, at the Neal S. Blaisdell Center, starting at 6:00 p.m.

All interested persons are urged to attend the public hearing and present data, views, or arguments in the time limit provided, for consideration by the Department of Enterprise Services.
