Renovations beginning for Kailua Beach Park bathhouse & pavilion

Kailua – A renovation project to improve the facilities of the Kailua Beach Park bathhouse & pavilion is scheduled to begin today.

The bathhouse & pavilion is located on northern end of the beach park near where the park is split by the Ka'elepulu Stream. It is accessed by the one-way driveway at the end of Kailua Road.

Improvements scheduled for the facility and the surrounding area include: roof repair, landscaping, sidewalk repair, new plumbing fixtures, interior and exterior wall renovations, and adding security measures to the facility.

The facility and the immediate area around the renovation site will be closed during the project. Construction fencing will mark the work area. The two outdoor showers near the facility will be available for public use.

The contract for the renovations was awarded to Maxum Construction of Hawaii, LLC at a cost of \$952,727.

The project is expected to be complete by July 2017.

We thank the public for their patience and understanding during the renovations.

Kailua Beach Park sits on just over 35-acres and was opened to the public in 1938.
