Winning artists and their posters will be celebrated through various media, and will help to promote Hawaii's tradition of placing lei on each grave site at the National Memorial Cemetery of the Pacific at Punchbowl.

All school students in Hawaii, Grades K – 12

- THEME** Posters will be entitled "Sew a Lei for Memorial Day" and will depict lei-making activities or ceremonial actions at the National Memorial Cemetery of the Pacific at Punchbowl
- CRITERIA** All entries will be judged on their appeal, originality, and effectiveness in conveying the message on lei-making or Memorial Day service activities.
- RULES & PROCEDURES** Drawings may be created on white or colored paper, or poster board. Pen and ink, crayons, pastels, and/or paints may be used. Drawings may not be computer enhanced and no cutouts. **PLEASE MAKE DRAWINGS 9 X 12 inches** vertical or horizontal format (correct size is essential for print, judging and display purposes). Drawings are limited to one side only. There is no limit on the number of colors used. Name, grade, school, teacher name and phone number, and island need to be on the back of drawings in the format of the form below. Paste labels or print clearly on the **BACK** of the poster entry on the **UPPER RIGHT HAND CORNER**. Limit of one entry per student.
- DOE SUBMISSION PROCESS** Schools should submit entries to their district offices by March 4, 2015. District offices should submit all entries to the DOE Communications Branch at 1390 Miller Street, Room 312 by March 5, 2015. Poster entries will be returned to the DOE Communications Branch for distribution upon completion of judging. For any questions regarding sending entries through DOE interdepartmental mail, call 586-3232. You may also mail entries directly to the Department of Parks and Recreation, Attn: Alex Ching, Kapolei Hale, 1000 Uluohia Street, Suite 309, Kapolei, Hawaii 96707. Mailed in entries must be received by March 5, 2015. We will not be responsible for lost or late mail delivery.
- JUDGING** Winners will be selected by a panel of judges on March 10, 2015. Honolulu Mayor Kirk Caldwell will present awards on May 6, 2015. Winning drawings will be displayed on the 3rd floor of Honolulu Hale from May 1 – 31, 2015.
- PRIZES** First, second, and third place winners will be chosen in three categories: Grades K-4, 5-8, and 9-12. The first place entries from each category will be used to create three separate Memorial Day Sew a Lei posters and be distributed statewide. Certificates will be presented to all who place in the contest.
- PRIVATE SCHOOLS** Submit entries to be received by March 5, 2015, to the Department of Parks and Recreation, Attn: Alex Ching, Kapolei Hale, 1000 Uluohia Street, Suite 309, Kapolei, Hawaii 96707. We will not be responsible for lost or late mail delivery. Entries will not be returned unless picked up at Kapolei Hale or by supplying a self addressed stamped envelope.
