

DID YOU KNOW?



Vehicles are not allowed to park within 30 feet of a stop sign.

Vehicles are not allowed to park within 10 - feet of a fire hydrant.



Vehicles are not allowed to park in front of, or within, four feet of either side of a driveway flare.



Vehicles are not allowed to park on, or, within 20 feet of a crosswalk.

FIVE EASY STEPS TO CITATION-FREE PARKING

PARKING METERS →



PAY the meter immediately after pulling into a metered parking stall. Meter time limits are enforced!

STREET PARKING TIME LIMITS →

CHECK signs to see how long you can park. On-Street meters usually have 1 or 2 hour time limits.

PARKING LOT TIME LIMITS →



CHECK signs to see how long you can park. Most city parking lots are enforced 24 hours daily, including weekends and holidays.

NO PARKING →

DO NOT park at "No Parking" signs. Metered stalls that are "Out of Order"/"Fail" are considered official "No Parking" signs. Do not park at broken meters.

TOW-AWAY ZONES →



READ "Tow-Away Zone" signs carefully for the times during which your vehicle could be towed.
