CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order by Chair Pattie Dunn at 12:00pm.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES: The minutes of the February 10, 2015 meeting were approved.

STATUS REPORTS/ISSUES:

Waialua Bike Path

The proposed Waialua Bike Path on Goodale Avenue was discussed at length. The Honolulu City Council added \$300,000 to the FY15 budget but the administration must release the funds. City Council added projects may or may not be implemented depending on the current budget environment. The administration is focusing on projects that support the rail project such as TOD or Complete Streets projects along the rail corridor.

On suggestion was to use Safe Routes to School funds for this project. SRTS funds are currently available and this project would seem to qualify for those funds. The Committee will write a memo to endorse the project. HPD has stolen bike reports but there is no statistics on how many bikes are recovered.

Bicycle Theft

The Committee acknowledged that bicycle theft is a real and growing problem. It was suggested that HPD should attend the MACB meetings. DTS will invite them. DTS is compiling information regarding bike thefts from HPD.

There also needs more education on how to properly lock your bike. HBL and UH have info on their websites. It might be possible to make a bike app or add it to the City's 311 app.

Another issue is that stolen bikes reported to HPD are not submitted to the bicycle registration offices for several months so there is a lag when checking to see if a bike is stolen when purchasing a used bike. DTS will coordinate with the various departments to try to remedy this situation.

Committee functions

Chris distributed a handout regarding the requested Powers, Duties and Functions information. There was also another sheet explaining the function of advisory committees in general.
